India's Seventh Navigation Satellite IRNSS-1G sucessfully launched

Question: Name the ISRO's Launch Vehicle which has launched IRNSS-1G, the seventh satellite of the Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System (IRNSS)?

Related facts:

- On 28 April 2016 ISRO's Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle, PSLV-C33 successfully launched the IRNSS-1G, the seventh satellite of the Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System (IRNSS).
- The satellite was launched from the First Launch Pad (FLP) of the Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota at 1250 hrs (12:50 pm) IST.
- The seventh and final satellite of the Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System, the IRNSS 1G, was launched into a sub geosynchronous transfer orbit with a perigree (nearest point to earth) of 284 km and an apogee (farthest point to earth) of 20,657 km.
- This was the thirty fourth consecutively successful mission of PSLV and the thirteenth in its 'XL' configuration.
- IRNSS-1G has a lift-off mass of 1425 kg.
- This launch also made India into the 5 selected nations that have their own GPS (Global Positioning System) or navigation system.
- The system will be similar to the Global Positioning System (GPS) operated by the United States with 24 satellites and the Glonass, Galileo and BeiDou systems of Russia, Europe and China respectively.
- IRNSS is an independent regional navigation satellite system designed to provide position information in the Indian region and 1500 km around the Indian mainland.
- IRNSS provides two types of services, namely, Standard Positioning Services (SPS) provided to all users and Restricted Services (RS) - provided to authorised users.
- This navigation system will be controlled by ISRO's Master Control Facility (MCF) at Hassan, Karnataka.
- It may recall that IRNSS-1G is the seventh of the seven satellites constituting the space segment of the Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System. IRNSS-1A, 1B, 1C, ID, IE and 1F, the first six satellites of the constellation, were successfully launched by PSLV on July 02, 2013, April 04, 2014, October 16, 2014, March 28, 2015, January 20, 2016 and March 10, 2016 respectively.
- On the Ocassion Prime Minister of India, Narendra Modi, heartily thanked and congratulated all the ISRO scientists and team ISRO for completing IRNSS constellation and dedicated IRNSS to the nation as 'NavIC' (Navigation Indian Constellation).

- On 22 April 2016 President Pranab Mukherjee nominated the six personalities from different fields to the House of Elders following a recommendation of the Narendra Modi government.
- Six members nominated to the Rajya Sabha include Subramanian Swamy, Navjot Singh Sidhu, Mary Kom, Narendra Jadhav, Suresh Gopi and Swapan Dasgupta.
- In the Rajya Sabha there are 12 nominated members, of which seven seats are empty at the moment.
- Six of the seven seats have been approved by the president.
- Mr Swamy, a Harvard-educated economist, was a former Union Minister for Commerce and Law. He was also a former member of the Planning Commission.
- Mr Sidhu, cricketer-turned-parliamentarian is three-time Lok Sabha member of BJP from Amritsar.
- 33-year-old Mary Kom, who hails from Manipur, is a five-time world amateur boxing champion and the only woman boxer to have won a medal in each one of the six world championships.
- Swapan Dasgupta is a senior journalist and has held different editorial posts at The Statesman, The Times of India and India Today besides others.
- Mr. Jadhav, apart from his economics writings is famous for penning a biography of his family, called Amchi Baap Ani Amhi in Marathi and was translated as Untouchables in English.
- Suresh Gopinathan, commonly known as Suresh Gopi, is an Indian film actor and singer who has starred in over 200 Malayalam films. The role of Kannan Perumalayan in Kaliyattam (1997) won him the National Film Award for Best Actor along with the Kerala State Film Award for Best Actor.



- Consumers can also purchase the fan by making UPFRONT payment of Rs. 1,250 for 50 watts fan.

 - 1. The Rules are now applicable beyond Municipal areas.
- This is extend to urban agglomerations, census towns, notified industrial townships, areas under the control of Indian Railways, airports, airbase, Port and harbour, defence establishments, special economic zones, State and Central government organizations, places of pilgrims, religious & historical importance.
 - 2. No person should throw, burn, or bury the solid waste generated by him, on streets, open public spaces outside his premises, or in the drain, or water bodies.
 - 3. Generator will have to pay 'User Fee' to waste collector and for 'Spot Fine' for Littering and Nonsegregation.
 - 4. Construction and demolition waste should be stored, separately disposed off, as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016
- The Government has also constituted a Central Monitoring Committee under the chairmanship of Secretary, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change to monitor the overall implementation of the Rules.
- It is estimated that about 62 million tonnes of waste is generated annually in the country.
- Out of which 5.6 million is plastic waste, 0.17 million is biomedical waste. In addition, hazardous waste generation is 7.90 million TPA (Tonnes Per Annum) and 15 lakh tonne is e-waste.

- The regular run of train no. 12050 H. Nizamuddin-Agra Cantt Gatimaan started from H.Nizamuddin station at 08.10 a.m. from 06.04.2016 to reach Agra Cantt. at 09.50 a.m. the same day.

- On April 4, the Union Minister for Human Resource Development Smriti Zubin released the India Rankings 2016 under National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) in New Delhi.
- The India Rankings 2016 is the first of its kind since the launch of NIRF on 29 September 2015.
 - It assessed the performance of higher educational institutions in India and ranked them accordingly. The ranking was divided into four categories namely Management, engineering, pharma and universities.
- The criteria for ranking included teaching/learning resources, research, graduation outreach/inclusivity and perception. The data for the first four parameters, which account for 90% of the weightage.
- The data was submitted by the institutions and verified by National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), a body constituted by the HRD ministry last year to conduct annual surveys.
- Predictably IIMs hog the top slots amongst the management institutions. The first six ranks are occupied by IIMs led by IIM Bangalore at 1st rank with a weighted score of 93.04, closely followed by IIM Ahmedabad (rank 2), IIM Calcutta (rank 3) and IIM Lucknow (rank 4) with weighted scores of 89.92, 87.45 and 86.13 respectively.
- In Engineering category the first five positions led by IIT Madras the top slot with a weighted score of 89.42 followed by IIT Bombay, IIT Kharagpur, IIT Delhi and IIT Kanpur with weighted score of 87.67, 83.91, 82.03 and 81.07 respectively.
- Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bengaluru is ranked as the first amongst universities with a weighted score of 91.81 closely followed by Institute of Chemical Technology, Mumbai, formerly University Department of Chemical Technology (UDCT), University of Mumbai, which stands at rank 2 with a weighted score of 87.58.
- Ranks 3 to 8 are occupied by the traditional, multi-disciplinary universities led by Jawaharlal Nehru University (rank 3) followed by University of Hyderabad (rank 4), Tezpur University (rank 5), University of Delhi (rank 6), Banaras Hindu University (rank 7) and Indian Institute of Space Science and Technology (rank 8) with weighted scores ranging from 86.46 (JNU) to 78.83 (IISST)
- In Pharmacy category, Manipal College of Pharmaceutical Sciences at rank 1 with a weighted score of 77.87 closely followed by University Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Chandigarh at 2 rank with a weighted score of 77.10. Jamia Hamdard (rank 3), Poona College of Pharmacy, Pune (rank 4) and Institute of Pharmacy, Nirma University (rank 5) obtained weighted scores of 71.39, 70.93 and 69.76 respectively.

- The Netherlands (8.76), Norway(8.79), Denmark(8.89) and New Zealand(10.01) has occupied 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th position respectively.
- The last five positions are occupied by China (176th), Syria (177th) Turkmenistan (178th), North Korea (179th) and Eritrea (180th).
- In this edition, India with a score of 43.17 has jumped three spots from the 136th position it had in 2015 and ranked 133rd in 2016.
- Among India's neighboring countries, Pakistan ranks 147th, Sri Lanka (141st), Afghanistan (120th), Bangladesh (144th), Maldives (112th) Nepal (105th) and Bhutan (94th).
- Among the Developed countries, United Kingdon is ranked 38th, United States (41^{st)}, France (45th), Japan (72nd) and Russia is placed at the 148th place.
- The Index is published annually by Reporters Sans Frontières (RSF) since 2002.



- It's a significant and symbolic achievement because Europe is the first region to eradicate the disease as part of a new UN-led strategy to wipe out malaria globally.
- Speaking ahead of World Malaria Day 2016 (on Monday, 25 April), WHO's Dr Nedret Emiroglu warned that the continent will remain vulnerable until the disease is beaten globally.
- According to the latest estimates from WHO, there were 214 million new cases of malaria worldwide in 2015 and there were an estimated 438 000 malaria deaths worldwide in 2015.
- It may be recalled that On 12 Feb. 2016 J P Nadda, Union Minister for Health & Family Welfare, launched the National Framework for Malaria Elimination (NFME) 2016-2030, which outlines India's strategy for elimination of the disease by 2030.
- Malaria is caused by Plasmodium parasites. The parasites are spread to people through the bites of infected female Anopheles mosquitoes, called "malaria vectors."
- Malaria is preventable and curable, and increased efforts can dramatically reduce the malaria burden in many places.



- According to the IMF the growth rate of the Indian economy is driven by private consumption and an increase in industrial activity.
- The report also marginally increased its growth projections by 0.2% percentage points for China to 6.5% and 6.2% in 2016 and 2017 respectively citing resilient domestic demand.

- At end-December 2015, India's external debt stock stood at US\$ 480.2 billion, recording an increase of US\$ 4.9 billion (1.0 per cent) over the level at end-March 2015.
- The rise in external debt during the period was due to long-term external debt particularly commercial borrowings and NRI deposits.
- However, on a sequential basis, total external debt at end December 2015 declined by US\$ 1.2 billion from the end-September 2015 level.
- At end-December 2015, long-term external debt accounted for 83.0 per cent of India's total external debt, while the remaining (17 per cent) was short-term debt.
- Long-term debt at end-December 2015 was US\$ 398.6 billion, showing an increase of US\$ 8.8 billion (2.3 per cent) over the level at end-March 2015.
- Short-term external debt witnessed a decline of 4.6 per cent and stood at US\$ 81.6 billion at end-December
- Government (sovereign) external debt stood at US\$ 90.7 billion at end-December 2015 while non-Government debt amounted to US\$ 389.5 billion.
- The share of Government (Sovereign) and non-Government debt in the total external debt was 18.9 per cent and 81.1 per cent respectively, at end-December 2015.
- The share of US dollar denominated debt continued to be the highest in external debt stock at 57.6 per cent at end-December 2015, followed by the Indian rupee (28.7 per cent), SDR (5.8 per cent), Japanese yen (4.1 per cent), and euro (2.3 per cent).
- The ratio of concessional debt to total external debt was 8.7 per cent at end-December 2015 (8.8 per cent at end-March 2015).
- India's foreign exchange reserves provided a cover of 73.0 per cent to the total external debt stock at end-December 2015 vis-à-vis 67.5 per cent at end-March 2015.
- The ratio of short term external debt to foreign exchange reserves was 23.3 per cent at end-December 2015 as against 26.7 per cent at end-March 2015.

 the requirement to 90 per cent with effect from the fortnight beginning April 16, 2016, while keeping the CRR
 unchanged at 4.0 per cent of net demand and time liabilities (NDTL).
- Effective from April 2, 2016 the statutory liquidity ratio (SLR) of scheduled commercial banks was reduced by 25 basis points from 21.5 per cent to 21.25 per cent of their NDTL.
- Consequently, the reverse repo rate under the LAF stands adjusted to 6.0 per cent, and the marginal standing facility (MSF) rate to 7.0 per cent. The Bank Rate which is aligned to the MSF rate also stands adjusted to 7.0 per cent.
- The GVA (Gross Value Added: GVA) growth projection for 2016-17 is estimated at 7.6 per cent.

- The large optical telescopes in India so far have mirrors of about 2-meter diameter only. The largest was the 2.3 meter diameter telescope situated at Kavalur in Tamilnadu since 1986.
- ARIES is an autonomous institute established in 2004 and is funded by Department of Science & Technology, Government of India.
- The main aim of ARIES is to carry out fundamental research in the field of astronomy, astrophysics and atmospheric sciences.
- The 3.6 meter telescope was established by ARIES, Nainital with a total project cost of nearly 150 Crore rupees.
- Considering the global importance of this telescope, the Belgian government through its science department BELSPO decided to participate in this project, and financed seven-percent of its total cost.
- The telescope can target exactly within an object of about 20 meter size at 1000 km distance.

- West Indies captain was Darren Sammy and England's captain was Eoin Morgan.
- Marlon Samuels scored 85 not out from 66 balls, and was named as "man of the match".
- This is the highest runs scored ever by an individual in T20 finals.
- Player of the Tournament award was presented to India's Virat Kohli, who scored 273 in the World Cup.
- Bangladesh's Tamim Iqbal scored 295, the highest in the World Cup.
- Afghanistan's Mohammad Nabi took 12 wickets, most in the World Cup.
- On March 16, 2016 West Indies batsman Chris Gayle made a record of making the fastest century in the ICC Twenty20 world cup.
- Gayle playing against England in Mumbai set a record by scoring an unbeaten 100 off 47 balls.
- Afghanistan reached in the second phase of the first Twenty20 World Cup and made it to the Super-10.
- On 18 March chasing 229 runs made by South Africa for victory, England scored 230 runs.
- This is the highest total chased by any team in Twenty20 World Cup in order to win the game.

- On March 27 in a match against Australia, Ravichandran Ashwin become the first Indian bowler to take 50 wickets in a Twenty20.
- Other Key facts of T20 World Cup 2016:
- Tamim Iqbal of Bangladesh scored most sixes(14) in the tournament.
- Most runs in an inning (230) scored by England against South Africa.
- Lowest runs of 70 were scored by Bangaladesh against England.
- Best bowling performance in an innings was performed by Mustafizur Rahman of Bangladesh (5 wickets against New Zealand by 22 runs).
- Best stats in Wicket Keeping is of 4 catches, 4 stumping which is acieved by Indian Captain M .S Dhoni.
- In 2007 the first Twenty20 World Cup was won by Indian team.
- Australia will host the 2020 Twenty20 world cup.
- A group of ex-players and commentators has selected ICC Twenty20 World Cup squad of the tournament.
- Indian vice-captain Virat Kohli has been selected as the captain of 12-member men's team.
- In addition, Ashish Nehra is another indian included in the squad.

- Prime Minsiser Narendra Modi on March 27, 2015 officially launched the programme.
- Maharashtra tops the list with 16.44 lakh consumers giving up subsidies. Uttar Pradesh saw nearly 13 lakh users give up subsidies, followed by Delhi (7.26 lakh).
- Five states of Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu account for roughly half of the people who have given up LPG subsidies.

Amendments in the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Bill, 2015

- On 20 April 2016 The Union Cabinet chaired by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi today gave its approval to move official amendments in the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Bill, 2015.
- The legislation will ensure expeditious utilization of accumulated unspent amounts available with the ad hoc Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA).



- Presently the accumulated unspent amounts available with CAMPA is of the order of Rs.40,000 crore, and fresh accrual of compensatory levies and interest on accumulated unspent balance, which will be of the order of approx. Rs. 6,000 crore per annum, in an efficient and transparent manner.
- Utilization of these amounts will facilitate timely execution of appropriate measures to mitigate impact of diversion of forest land, utilisation of these amounts will result in creation of productive assets and generation of huge employment opportunities in the rural areas, especially the backward tribal areas.

The following amendments are proposed in Bill:

- Amendment of clause 2 (e) of the Bill to make the list of environmental services inclusive and to delete some of environmental services for which credible model to assess their monetary value does not exist.
- Amendment of clauses 2 (I) and 30 (1) of the Bill to provide for prior consultation with States Governments for making rule under the new legislation.
- Amendment of clause 6 (d) of the Bill to provide for use of monies realised from the user agencies in lieu for forest land diverted in protected areas for voluntary relocation from protected areas.
- Amendment of clause 8 (4) (ii) of the Bill 'to include Secretaries of Ministries dealing with Space and Earth Sciences as members of governing body of the National Authority.
- Amendment of clause 8 (4) (x) of the Bill to increase the number of expert members in governing body of National Authority from two to five.
- Amendment of clause 9 (2) (ix) of the Bill to increase the number of expert members in executive committee of National Authority from two to three.
- Amendments of clause 11 (2) and 11 (3) of the Bill to include an expert on tribal matters or representative of tribal community as a member in both steering committee and executive committee of a State Authority.
- It may be recalled that on 13th May, 2015 Lok Sabha referred the Bill to the Department-related Parliamentary Standing Committee on Science & Technology, Environment & Forests. On 26th February, 2016 the Committee submitted its report to the Parliament. The government has amended the bill on the basis of this report.

- State residents living in urban areas, which are governed by the municipalities or state development authorities, can seek a certificate of ownership of their lands by paying a nominal fee to the state government.
- The state government will set up an authority which will be headed by an Indian Administrative Service (IAS) Officer.
- The authority will seek all the documents from the landowners, and will verify it against records held by the state.
- The authority will first issue a provisional certificate for two yeras for which the state will not stand guarantee. If there are no objections or dispute arises, the authority will issue a certificate and a map to the owner other land or property with state guarantee.
- Currently, it is kept voluntary for the owners to apply for this certificate.
- The state government has kept the application fee of 0.5% of the land rate determined by a district level committee to encourage more people to join this new scheme.
- Through the Bill the state government has given itself the power to enter into any property or premise for the purpose of survey by giving its owner a prior notice.
- Experts believe that this Bill will give a clear title to the owner and will reduce litigations in the courts. This is seen as one of the key steps towards land reforms and Rajasthan has become the first state to introduce in the country.
- Since the Vasundhara Raje took charge two years ago, the state has undertaken a series of labour and industry reforms. It has also opened many sector for public-private partnership, earning mixed response from residents, activists and industrialists.




