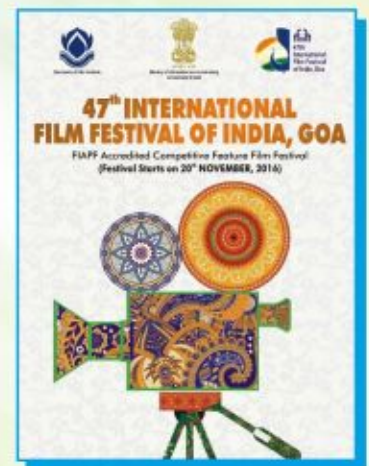

Related facts:

- On 27 December 2016 Ministry of Corporate Affairs released its Year End Review – 2016. On 27 December 2016 Ministry of Labour & Employment has released Yearend review-2016.
- Following are the related key facts:**
- The Payment of Bonus (Amendment) Bill, 2015 passed by the Parliament in the Winter Session has been published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary on 1st January, 2016. The Maternity Benefit (Amendment) Bill, 2016 passed by Rajya Sabha on 11th August, 2016 which inter-alia include increasing maternity benefit to woman from 12 weeks to 26 weeks up to two surviving children.
- The Employees' Compensation (Amendment) Bill, 2016 was passed in Lok Sabha on 9th August, 2016 to modify the provisions of Employees' Compensation Act, 1923 to rationalize the penalties and strengthen the rights of the worker under the Act.
- The Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Amendment Bill, 2016, passed by the Parliament on 26th July, 2016.
- Cabinet in its meeting held on 29th June, 2016 considered the Model Shops and Establishment (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Bill, 2016.
- The 2nd National Commission on Labour had recommended codification of Labour Laws in to 4-5 Groups on functional basis.
- At present, Ministry of Labour & Employment is working to rationalize the provisions of the 43 Labour Laws in 4 Labour Codes which are Labour Code on Wages, Labour Code on Industrial Relations, Labour Code on Social Security & Welfare and Labour Code on Safety & Working Conditions. The government has announced more than 42% increase in the minimum wages for all sectors in the central sphere.
- ESI coverage on Wage ceiling has been increased from Rs.15000/- to Rs.21000/-. Bonus ceiling has been enhanced from Rs.3500/- to Rs.7000/- and the eligibility limit has been raised from Rs.10000/- to Rs.21000/. Revised scheme for the rehabilitation of Bonded Labour with the quantum of financial assistance increased from the symbolic level of Rs 20 thousand to an amount of Rs 3 lakhs Time limit reduced to 20 days from 30 days for EPF claim settlements.
- A unified Web Portal 'Shram Suvidha Portal' launched on 16.10.2014 to bring transparency and accountability in enforcement of labour laws and ease complexity of compliance.
- Universal Account Number (UAN) programme launched on 16th October 2014 is designed to act as an umbrella for the multiple Member IDs allotted to same individual.
- The Ministry is implementing the Pradhan Mantri Rojgar Protsahan Yojana (PMRPY) scheme to incentivize employers registered with the Employees Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) for new employment.
- The Ministry is implementing the National Career Service (NCS) Project as a vibrant platform for transforming and strengthening the public employment services in the country.

Related facts:



- On 26 December 2016; Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution released its Year End Review of 2016.
- Following are the related facts:
- The National Food Security Act (NFSA) was enacted in 2013 and was being implemented in only 11 States/UTs in May, 2014.
- As a result, 13 more States/UTs joined NFSA during the year and the Act is now being implemented in all the States/UTs and covers about 80 crore persons under the Act.
- Sustained efforts have resulted in significant reforms in TPDS making it more transparent and leak proof with better targeting of food subsidy.
- As a result thereof, 100% of ration cards have been digitized while 71.13% have been Aadhaar seeded.
- Online allocation of food grains has started in 29 States/UTs, Supply chain has been computerized in 19 States/UTs and 1,76,834 Fair Price Shops (FPS) have been automated by installing 'Point of Sale' devices.
- 6 States have now automated all their FPSs.
- Cash Transfer for foodgrains under Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) scheme has been implemented in 3 UTs namely Chandigarh, Puducherry w.e.f. 1-9-2015 and in Dadra & Nagar Haveli (in urban areas) w.e.f. 01-03-2016.
- Total beneficiaries covered under the scheme is 9.14 lakh and total amount of funds transferred is Rs.11.98 crore per month.
- During Rabi Marketing Season (RMS) 2016-17, Govt. agencies have procured 229.32 lakh MT wheat as on 01.12.2016.
- For the Kharif Marketing Season (KMS) 2015-16 (October, 2015-September 2016), 342.19 Lakh tons of paddy in terms of rice has been procured.
- In KMS 2016-17, 178.29 LMT of paddy in terms of rice has been procured till 13.12.2016.
- Government took a number of measures like providing financial assistance of Rs. 413 crore through raw sugar export incentive scheme.
- Financial assistance of Rs. 4305 crore under soft loan scheme has been provided by Government.
- 99.33% of cane dues payments of farmers for 2014-15 sugar season and 98% (on FRP-basis) for 2015-16 sugar season have been cleared. .
- Sufficient food grains are available in Central Pool Stocks of FCI. Stocks as on 1.12.2016 are 275.55 lakh MT (LMT), comprising 164.96 LMT wheat and 110.59 LMT rice which is more than adequate for Government welfare schemes as well as needs of PDS and other buffer stocking.
- To bring all operations of FCI godowns online and to check leakage and automate operations at the depot level, 'Depot Online' system has been launched in 31 Depots on pilot basis across 27 States on 17th March 2016.
- As on 30.11.2016, this system has been implemented in 494 depots
- FCI has developed a software for Online Procurement Management System (OPMS) which is being used for procurement in the KMS 2016-17.

- Buffer stock of about 6.95 lakh tonnes of pulses built under Price Stabilization Fund (PSF) scheme of the Department utilizing budgetary allocation.

Related facts:

- On 21 December 2016 Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports released its Year end Review of 2016.
- Following are the related highlights:
- In Rio Paralympics – 2016 India won its highest ever medal tally of 4 medals (2 Gold, 1 Silver and 1 Bronze all in athletics).
- The athletes are Shri Devendra Jhajharia and Shri Mariappan, Gold medalists, Ms Deepa Malik, Silver medalist and Shri Varun Singh Bhati, Bronze medalist.
- Participation of Athletes ensuring and making all arrangements for participation of the largest ever contingent of India in Olympics / Paralympics 2016 in Rio.
- India won 2 medals in Olympics (1 silver and 1 Bronze in Badminton and wrestling respectively).
- 12th South Asian Games were successfully conducted at Guwahati and Shillong in February 2016.
- India won a record-breaking haul of 308 medals.
- India's final tally stood at 188 gold, 99 silver and 30 bronze medals.
- It was a massive jump in medal count for the Indians compared to the previous edition of the Games in 2010 in which India won 175, including 90 gold.
- BRICS U-17 Football tournament: First ever U-17 Football tournament among teams of five BRICS countries was organized and successfully held at Goa in October 2016.
- Brazil was the winner of this tournament.
- Run for Rio on 31st July, 2016 was organized to create awareness among masses about Rio Olympics and to convey wishes of the country-men to Olympians and Paralympians participating in Rio for 2016.
- Indian U-18 Men Hockey Team won gold in 4th at Dhaka Asia cup beating Bangladesh in the final at Dhaka.
- MoU between India and New Zealand on cooperation in the field of Youth and Sports: A MoU was signed between the two countries on 28th October, 2016 at New Delhi.
- Launch of a new scheme 'Khelo India – National Programme for Development of Sports' India beat Belgium 2-1 to win junior hockey world cup title on 18.12.2016.

- On 23 December 2016; Ministry of Information & Broadcasting released its Year End Review.
- Following are the main highlights:
- Ministry of I&B organized a two day State Information Ministers Conference 28th SIMCON after a gap of 7 years on 9-10 December, 2016.
- It was organised to promote the vision of One Nation & Cooperative Federalism.
- The theme of the conference was Reform, Perform and Transform: A New Dimension of Communication.
- Ministry has also introduced a cash component of Rs. 1 Crore in the Most Film Friendly State Award to promote India as a Filming destination.
- In a major push to Community radio Movement in the Country, I&B Minister announced increased subsidy for setting up of Community Radio Stations from 50 % to 90% in the North Eastern States and 75% in other States, subject to a maximum limit of Rs. 7.5 lakhs.
- Simplification of Annual Renewal process for existing TV channels as part of "Ease of Doing Business".
- A total of 170 channels have been given licences from Jun 2014 till Dec 2016. Of these, 25 licences are given to News channels and 145 licences have been to non-news channels.
- Recently Ministry has extended the cutoff date for Phase IV to 31st March, 2017.
- Special 5 minutes Bulletin on Swachhta has been started on all weekdays.
- Swachh Bharat Short Film Festival organized by the NFDC on behalf of the Ministry, has received over 4000 entries from across the country in various Indian languages on the theme of the Swachh Bharat Mission.
- Young filmmaker Katyayan Shivpuri, from Maharashtra, won the first prize at the Swachh Bharat Short Film Festival for his work "Murga".
- The first ever BRICS Film Festival took place at Siri Fort auditorium in New Delhi from September 2-6, 2016.
- European Union Film Festival took place at Siri Fort auditorium in New Delhi from 30 July to 6 August where a total of 23 movies from the European Union countries were showcased.
- Iranian Film Festival (16-19 July 2016) took place at Siri Fort auditorium in New Delhi where 14 films of the acclaimed and award winning film makers from Iran were screened.
- On the domestic policy front the Ministry organised Swachh Bharat Short Film Festival, Children's Film Festival and the Patriotic Film Festival with theme Azaadi 70 Saal, Yaad Karo Qurbani.
- The three-day National Children's Film Festival (NCFF) was held from November 14 to 16 in Jaipur, Rajasthan.
- National Film Heritage Mission (NFHM): It is a new Plan Scheme to restore, digitize and archive films and filmic material through National Film Archive of India.
- National Film Archives of India in one of its rare discovery, NFAI acquired 20.43 minutes of the Indian Silent Film Bilwamangal (1919), thanks to the wonderful cooperation of the Cinematheque Francaise.
- It is after 21 years that a silent film has entered NFAI vaults.
- In order to promote transparency and accountability in issuing of Government advertisements in print media and weeding out ghost/irregular newspapers government launched New Print Media Advertisement Policy for DAVP.
- 360 degree Multimedia Campaigns to give wide publicity to the schemes launched by the Government.

- The activities range from holding of Press conferences, telecast/broadcast of special programmes on DD and AIR with experts, Multimedia Exhibitions, social media campaigns using Infographics, animations, graphic plates, short videos, live streaming of events /conferences.
- Publications Division has released the E-version of the India/ Bharat-2016. Online payment and subscription services for popular journals and Employment News of Publications Division through Bharat Kosh Portal of Ministry of Finance.
- Release of books on Rashtrapati Bhavan published by the Publications Division.
- Some of the books are “Around India’s First Table: Dining and Entertaining at Rashtrapati Bhavan”, “The Arts and Interiors of Rashtrapati Bhavan: Lutyens and Beyond”, “Discover the Magnificent World of Rashtrapati Bhavan”, “A Work of Beauty: The Architecture and Landscape of Rashtrapati Bhavan”, “First Garden of the Republic: Nature in the President’s Estate” among others.
- A book on Courts of India- Past to Present published by the Publications Division under the guidance of the Hon’ble Supreme Court was also released.

Ministry of Shipping: Year-end Review-2016

Question: What is the total length of the Indian coastal line

Related facts:

- On 22 December, 2016; Ministry of Shipping released its Year-end Review for 2016.
- Following are the main highlights:
- The Ports play an important role in the trade of the country. In fact they are the Gateways for the EXIM Trade.
- Over all the ports in the Country handle 90% by volume and 70% by value of India’s external trade.
- India’s has a coastline of 7,517 kms with potentially navigable waterways of 14,500 kms. 12 major and 200 non major ports are dotted along the coast.
- The cargo handled by major ports went up by 6.27% in FY 2016-17 (Apr-Oct) to 370.04 million tonnes (MT) compared to 348.21 MT during the same period previous year.
- 56 New Projects worth INR 25000 crores have been awarded during the last two years, which will create an additional port capacity of 317 million tonnes per annum.
- Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) of up to 100 per cent allowed under the automatic route for port and harbour construction and maintenance projects.
- Ship building and ship repair policy approved in December 2015 provides a boost to the shipbuilding and ship repair industry.
- National Waterways (NWs) Act 2016 to promote inland waterways for trade came into effect on April 12, 2016.
It has declared 106 new waterways as NWs.
- The new Berthing Policy that came into effect on August 20, 2016.
- It aims to reduce berthing time and overall turn-around time of ships, standardize anchorage charges etc. across major ports.
- Award of Waterfront and Associated Land policy was approved on July 27, 2016.
- The Cabinet approved the ‘The Merchant Shipping Bill, 2016’ in November 2016.



- The Cabinet also approved 'The Major Ports Bill, 2016 in December 2016 that advocates for greater autonomy to port boards.
- Total FDI equity inflows in Sea Transport and Ports sector was USD 1.07 billion during the two years from April 2014 to September 2016.
- Infrastructure status for shipyards was granted in May, 2016. This will enable Indian shipyards to avail cheaper long-term financing for Indian shipbuilding and ship repair industry.
- The ambitious Sagarmala project envisages a port-led economy through infrastructure development in ports and integration of ports with Special Economic Zones, Port based Smart Cities, Industrial Parks, Warehouses, Logistics Parks and Transport Corridors.
- A total of 173 projects identified under the National Perspective Plan (NPP) for the Sagarmala Programme, at an estimated investment of INR 4 lakh crore, has been initiated during FY 2016-17 6 new mega ports have been identified to add 400 MTPA of cargo handling capacity.
- These are namely Vadhavan (Maharashtra), Enayam (Tamil Nadu), Cuddalore/ Shikazhi (Tamil Nadu), Machilipatnam /Vodarevu (Andhra Pradesh), Paradip South Satellite Port (Odisha), Sagar (West Bengal).
- Saurashtra (Gujarat) and Chennai (Tamil Nadu) have been identified for setting up Maritime Clusters.
- Andaman and Nicobar have been identified for setting up of a marine tourism and maintenance, repair and operation (MRO) cluster.
- A direct container service was launched between Myanmar and India at Chennai Port in October 2014.
- Maritime India Summit 2016 was held on 14-16 April, 2016.
- It played a key role in highlighting the role of port led development for faster and sustainable economic growth.
- The summit provided a platform for participation, engagement and interaction from 42 countries.
- As part of Sagarmala, more than 400 projects, at an estimated infrastructure investment of more than Rs. 7 lakh crore, have been identified across the areas of port modernization & new port development, port connectivity enhancement, port-linked industrialization and coastal community development.
- The Sagarmala Development Company (SDC) was incorporated on 31st August 2016.

Related facts:

- On 28 December 2016 Union Cabinet has given its ex-post facto approval to the proposal of Ministry of New & Renewable Energy (MNRE) for ratification of ISA's Framework Agreement by India.
- ISA was launched jointly by the Prime Minister of India and the President of France on 30th November, 2015 at Paris.
- This was launched the side-lines of the 21st CoP meeting of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.



- The ISA will strive to bring together more than 121 solar resource rich nations for coordinated research, low cost financing and rapid deployment.
 - The foundation stone of the ISA Headquarters was laid at Gwal Pahari, Guragaon in Haryana.
 - India has already committed the required support of operationalization of ISA.
 - ISA will put India globally in a leadership role in climate and renewable energy issues.
 - It will also give a platform to showcase its solar programmes.
 - The Agreement was opened for signature on the sidelines of 22nd CoP meeting at Marrakesh, Morocco.
- Till now, 25 nations have signed the Framework Agreement.
- UNDP (United Nations Development Programme) and World Bank have already announced their partnership with the ISA.

- The Companies (Amendment) Bill, 2016 was introduced in the Lok Sabha on 16th March, 2016 proposing to amend Companies Act, 2013[CA-13].
- On 15th December, 2016 out of 470 sections, 422 sections of the Companies Act, 2013 have been notified. 39 sections are omitted by Insolvency Banking Code (IBC).
- The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 (Code) was published in the Official Gazette on 28th May, 2016.
- Government of India (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1961 were amended and notified on 1st Aug, 2016.
- The constitution of National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) and National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCALT) have been notified on 01st June, 2016.

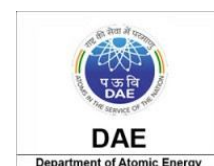

Related facts:



- On 20 December 2016; Department of Atomic Energy released its Year end Review.
- Following are the main highlights:
- Unit 1, (1000 MWe) of the Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project (KKNPP) was dedicated to the nation on August 10, 2016 by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Russian President Vladimir Putin.
- Second Nuclear power reactor Unit of 1000 MWe capacity at Kudankulam in Tamil Nadu achieved criticality on 10th July, 2016.
- On October 15, 2016, laying of Foundation Concrete of Units 3&4 of KKNPP was also done by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Russian President Vladimir Putin.
- Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi and the Japanese Prime Minister Shri Shinzo Abe signed the Agreement for Cooperation in the Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy between the two countries, on November 11, 2016.
- India becomes Associate Member of CERN, Geneva on 21 November 2016.
- The Union Cabinet has given its 'in principle' approval to the LIGO-India mega science proposal for research on gravitational waves, on February 17, 2016.
- India supplied indigenous teletherapy machine Bhabhatron, for cancer treatment to Bougando Medical Centre in Tanzania.
- Scientists at the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, DAE have developed a novel design of CO₂ sorbents that show superior CO₂ capture capacity and stability over conventional materials.
- BARC and Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences & Technology sign MoU for joint development of Deep Brain Stimulator on August 12, 2016.
- BARC develops kit for detection of Chromium contamination of water on 17 August 2016.
- A three-day International conference on "India's role in Global Nuclear Governance" was organised in New Delhi from February 24-26, 2016.
- A National Symposium on "Public Education on Radiation Safety" was held in New Delhi on February 16, 2016.
- The 8th Nuclear Energy Conclave was organised by India Energy Forum in New Delhi on September 30, 2016.
- The Theme of the Conference this year was "Meeting the Non-Fossil Energy Targets through Nuclear Power".
- On January 16, 2016 Northern India's first permanent exhibition on nuclear power, built in the national capital at National Science Centre (NSC) inaugurated.

State visit of President of Tajikistan to India

Related facts:

- On 14-18 December, 2016; Emomali Rahmon, President of the Republic of Tajikistan paid a State visit to India.
- During his visit he met with President Pranab Mukherjee, Vice President M. Hamid Ansari and Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
- President of Tajikistan and Prime Minister of India held wide-ranging talks on bilateral, regional and international issues.
- The two leaders discussed situation in the region and stressed that terrorism and extremism seriously threaten peace, stability and progress for all countries.



- Following agreements/MOUs were exchanged during the State visit of President of Tajikistan to India:
 1. Memorandum of Understanding between the Committee of television and radio under the Government of Tajikistan and the Prasar Bharati, India for cooperation on Broadcasting in Exchange of Audio Visual Programs.
 2. Protocol amending the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan and the Government of India for the avoidance of double taxation and prevention of fiscal evasion with respect to taxes on income.
 3. MoU between Financial Intelligence Unit of India and the Financial Monitoring Department under the National bank of Tajikistan concerning cooperation in the exchange of financial intelligence related to money laundering, related crimes and financing of terrorism.

The Right of Persons with Disabilities Bill, 2014

Related facts:

- On 14th December, 2016 the Rajya Sabha passed The Right of Persons with Disabilities Bill, 2014 with amendments.
- The bill will now go back to Lok Sabha and once cleared, will replace the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995.
- This bill was drafted on the basis of the recommendations of the Sudha Kaul Committee, under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and it has been pending in Rajya Sabha since 2014.
- According to the 2011 Census, the number of disabled in India stands at 2.21 per cent of the population. The Bill is more likely to make a larger number of people eligible for rights and entitlements by reason of their disability since it recognises more disabilities as compared to the 1995 Act.
- The Bill also complies with the UN Convention on Rights of Persons with Disabilities which was ratified by India on the 1st October, 2007.
- The new bill covers 19 conditions, instead of seven disabilities specified in the Act. While the 1995 Act recognised 7 disabilities — blindness, low vision, leprosy-cured, hearing impairment, locomotor disability, mental retardation and mental illness, the 2014 Bill was



expanded to cover 19 conditions— including cerebral palsy, haemophilia, multiple sclerosis, autism and thalassaemia among others. The amended version also recognises two other disabilities — resulting from acid attacks and Parkinson's disease.

- The Bill has also laid down provisions to allow the central government to notify any other condition as a disability.
- The Bill mentions that individuals with at least 40 per cent of a disability are entitled to benefits like reservations in education and employment, preference in government schemes and others. While the 1995 law had 3 per cent reservation provision.
- One of the most significant highlights is the addition of penalty for violating the rules of the Act. The current amendments to the Bill, propose to remove the jail term entirely, and only keep fines for breaking the law.
- The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Bill, 2014 seeks to improve the overall conditions that prevail in the country for people with different kinds of disabilities.

- On 12-13 December 2016: the President of Indonesia, Joko Widodo was on a state visit to India.
- This was the first bilateral visit to India by President Joko Widodo.
- On 12 December 2016 President Joko Widodo held a meeting with President of the Republic of India, Pranab Mukherjee.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi and President Joko Widodo held extensive talks on bilateral, regional and global issues of mutual interest.
- It should be known that Vice President of India M. Hamid Ansari, who had visited Indonesia in November 2015, called on the President of Indonesia.
- India and Indonesia have shared two millennia of close cultural and commercial contacts.
- The Hindu, Buddhist and later Muslim faith travelled to Indonesia from the shores of India.
- During the State Visit of President Mr S. B. Yudhoyono to India in 2005, the two countries signed a Joint Declaration on Establishing a Strategic Partnership.
- In January 2011, President Yudhoyono visited India as the Chief Guest on the occasion of India's Republic Day
- Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh visited Indonesia on 10-12 October 2013.
- There are around 100,000 Indonesians of Indian origin in Indonesia mostly concentrated in Greater Jakarta, Medan, Surabaya and Bandung.
- They are mainly engaged in trade dealing in textiles and sports goods.
- There are around 10,000 Indian nationals living in Indonesia including engineers, consultants, chartered accountants, bankers and other professionals.
- Recently India and Indonesia have signed three agreements in various areas to enhance strategic partnership.



- These agreements were signed after delegation level talks between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and visiting President of Indonesia Joko Widodo in New Delhi.
 1. MoU on Youth and Sports Cooperation.
 2. MoU on Standardization Cooperation.
 3. Joint Communiqué on Voluntary International Cooperation to Combat Illegal, Unregulated and Unreported (IUU) Fishing and to promote Sustainable Fisheries Governance.
- Besides, both countries decided to strengthen their defence and maritime security relations and resolved to effectively address the issue of terrorism.
- Prime Minister Modi congratulated President Widodo on Indonesia's able leadership as Chair of the IORA and the convening of the First IORA Summit next year.
- The two Leaders agreed to follow up on the discussions that they have had, and to carry forward the bilateral relations with meetings of the following mechanisms within the first half of 2017:
 - i). The Ministerial level Joint Commission
 - ii). The Defence Ministers' Dialogue and the Joint Defence Cooperation Committee (JDCC)
 - iii). Biennial Trade Ministers' Forum (BTMF)
 - iv). Convening of the meeting of the Energy Forum to develop a road map for energy cooperation
 - v). Establishment of a security dialogue in order to develop a comprehensive action plan on security cooperation.

Cyclone Vardah

Question: Name 'Vardah' was given to the recent Cyclone hitting Chennai. This name was suggested by which of the following country?

Related facts:

- Cyclone Vardah struck the Chennai coast on Monday, 12th December, 2016 afternoon, making landfall about 15 km from Chennai.
- The winds at landfall on Monday were around 140 kilometers per hour (87 miles per hour), making Vardah equal to a Category 1 hurricane on the Saffir-Simpson scale.
- It has moved inland, bringing gusty winds and torrential rainfall to the interior portions of Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka states.
- At least 12 people were killed in Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh as a severe cyclonic storm barrelled through India's southeast coast, uprooting trees, flattening homes and overturning vehicles.
- As per the Regional Meteorological Centre in Chennai the cyclonic storm is likely to weaken into a depression in the coming hours but wind speed may hover around the 70 km/hour mark.
- National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) teams are conducting relief and rescue operations in storm-hit areas of Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh.
- **Formation of the Cyclone:**



- Under the influence of a persistent area of convection, a low pressure area formed in Malay Peninsula and adjoining north Sumatra. It emerged as a tropical disturbance in the following days and moved slowly towards southeast Bay of Bengal. On 6 December, The IMD classified the system as Depression BOB 06 as it had sufficiently organized itself with winds exceeding 45 km/h. Owing to low wind shear and favorable sea surface temperatures, the storm gradually intensified into a deep depression the following day. BOB 06 was upgraded to a cyclonic storm by the IMD on 8 December, assigning it the name Vardah.
- It is notable that Tropical cyclones passing over the northern part of the Indian Ocean are named by eight countries in the region, namely India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Maldives, Myanmar, Oman and Thailand. The process began in 2004. The names are picked from this pre-designated list and are usually familiar with the people living in the region. The name Vardah, which means red rose, was given by Pakistan. India has so far contributed the following names: Agni, Bijli, Akash, Jal, Lehar, Megh, Sagar and Vayu.
- **Difference between hurricane, cyclone and typhoon**
- There is no difference among the three, except that they differ in terms of their geographical location. Hurricanes form in Atlantic and the Northeast Pacific oceans, typhoons in Northwest Pacific ocean and cyclones in South Pacific and Indian oceans.

Question: On 5 December 2016 Tamil Nadu Chief Minister J Jayalalithaa passed away, When did she become the Chief Minister of Tamilnadu for the first time?

Related facts:

- On 5 December, 2016; Tamil Nadu Chief Minister J Jayalalithaa passed away at the Apollo Hospitals, Chennai following cardiac arrest.
- She was 68.
- She was born on 24 February 1948 at Melkote in Mandya district in then Mysore State (now Karnataka).
- At birth she was named Komalavalli and was renamed Jayalalithaa.
- She had entered into film industry when she was 16 years old and worked in 300 films.
- She had acted in Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam, Hindi and English films.
- She made her debut as the lead actress in Kannada films while still in school, age 15, in Chinnada Gombe (1964).
- She also appeared in a dance sequence of a song named "Malligeya Hoovinantha" in the movie Amarashilpi Jakannachari (1964).
- She acted in one Hindi film called Izzat, with Dharmendra as her male costar in 1968.
- Jayalalithaa was nominated and elected to that body in 1984 and retained her seat until 1989.



- After MGR's death in 1987, Jayalalithaa proclaimed herself his political heir and, having fought off the faction headed by Janaki Ramachandran, MGR's widow, emerged as the sole leader of the AIADMK.
- In 1991 Jayalalithaa became chief minister, Tamil Nadu's youngest, for the first time.
- She served five terms(1st Term: 24.6.1991 – 12.5.1996; 2nd Term: 14.5.2001 – 21.9.2001 3rd Term: 2.3.2002 – 12.5.2006; 4th term: 16.5.2011 – 27.9.2014; 5th term: 23.5.2015 – Present) as the Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, for over fourteen years between 1991 and 2016.
- On 22 September 2016, Jayalalithaa was admitted to Apollo Hospitals in Chennai, as she suffered from infection and acute dehydration.
- On December 4, she was re-admitted to the critical care unit after suffering a cardiac arrest.
- On December 5, the hospital officially announced her death 23:30 IST.
- Two hours after the announcement of her death, in a simple ceremony at Raj Bhavan O. Panneerselvam was sworn in as the 20th Chief Minister of the state.

- India-Qatar cooperation in diverse sectors has been steadily growing in an excellent framework provided by historically close ties and regular and substantive engagement, including at the highest levels of the two Governments.
- The visit of Qatari Emir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani to India in March 2015 was followed by visit of Prime Minister Modi to Qatar this June.
- Not only an important trading partner for India in the Gulf region, Qatar is also the largest supplier of LNG to it, accounting for 66 per cent of the total imports in 2015-16.
- Indians form the largest expatriate community in Qatar and their positive contribution in the progress and development of their host country is well recognised.
- There are over 630,000 Indian nationals working in Qatar.
- Four agreements signed during the visit of Prime Minister of Qatar to India are:
- I. Agreement between the Government of the Republic of India and the Government of the State of Qatar on exemption from visa requirement for holders of diplomatic, special and official passports.
- II. Protocol on Technical Cooperation in cyber space and combating cyber crime between the Ministry of Home Affairs of the Republic of India and the Ministry of Interior of the State of Qatar.



- III. Letter of Intent between the Government of the Republic of India and the Government of the State of Qatar regarding negotiations on an Agreement on grant of e-Visa for businessmen and tourists of the two countries.
- IV. MoU between Supreme Committee for Delivery & Legacy of Qatar and Confederation of Indian Industry.

- The apex court stated that everyone present in the cinema halls must rise and pay respect to the national anthem.
- The court's directions came on a PIL filed by Shyam Narayan Chouksey seeking directions that the national anthem should be played in cinema halls across the country before a film begins and proper norms and protocol be fixed regarding its playing and singing at official functions and the programmes where constitutional dignitaries are present.
- The Supreme Court took note of Article 51(A) of the Constitution which makes respecting the National Anthem a fundamental duty of every citizen.
- A bench of Dipak Misra and Amitava Roy said that it is the duty of every citizen of the country to show respect to the national anthem and the flag.
- The Prevention of Insults to National Honour Act, 1971 is an Act of the Parliament of India which prohibits desecration of or insult to the country's national symbols, including the National Flag, The Constitution, Indian map and the National Anthem.
- If someone found doing so, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three years, or with fine, or with both.

- On 30 November 2006 the Union Cabinet has given its approval to notify inclusion and amendments in the Central List of Other Backward Classes (OBC).
- It was notified in respect of the eight states of Assam, Bihar, Himachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir and Uttarakhand.
- The union cabinet approved amendments to the central list of other backward classes (OBCs) to include 28 communities in eight states.
- On the recommendation of the National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), a total of 2479 entries for inclusion, including its synonyms, sub-castes, etc. in the Central List of Other Backward Classes have been notified in 25 states and 5 Union Territories.
- The changes will enable the persons belonging to these castes/ communities to avail the benefits of reservation in Government services and posts as well as in Central Educational Institutions as per the existing policy.
- They will also become eligible for benefit under the various welfare schemes, scholarships etc. being administered by the Central Government, which are at present available to the persons belonging to the Other Backward Classes.

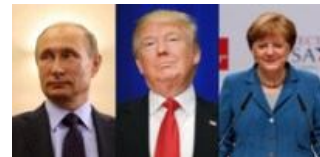

- On 25 December 2016 Government of India launched Lucky Grahak Yojana and Digi-Dhan Vyapar Yojana in order to promote digital payment methods.
- The schemes are aimed at encouraging people to move towards significantly higher usage of digital transactions through the offer of incentives.
- Winners will be selected on a daily and weekly basis under the Lucky Grahak Yojana and weekly basis under the Digi-Dhan Vyapar Yojana respectively.
- Under the Lucky Grahak Yojana, 15,000 consumers will get Rs. 1,000 each daily; the weekly prizes will be worth Rs. 1 lakh, Rs. 10,000, and Rs. 5,000, and will be distributed between 7,000 consumers.
- The mega draw on April 14 will have prizes of Rs. 1 crore, Rs. 50 lakh, and Rs. 25 lakh. The government will announce total of 100 winners for USSD payments, 1,500 winners each for UPI and AEPS transactions, and 11,900 winners for RuPay.
- Under Digi Dhan Vyapar Yojana 7,000 merchants per week stand to win rewards of Rs. 50,000, Rs. 5,000, and Rs. 2,500 each week from December 25, 2016 to April 14, 2017.
- The mega draw, which will take place on April 14, will have rewards worth Rs. 50 lakh, Rs. 25 lakh, and Rs. 5 lakh.
- The draws for these events will take place in 100 different cities around India, in an event at each of these cities where DigiDhan Mela will also be organised.
- NITI Aayog, along with the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) as its implementation partner, launched the two major schemes – Lucky Grahak Yojana for consumers and Digi-Dhan Vyapar Yojana for merchants.
- In order to participate in Lucky Grahak Yojana and Digi Dhan Vyapar Yojana, one needs to make digital payments through either of the following modes: UPI (Unified Payment Interface), RuPay, AEPS (Aadhaar Enabled Payment System), and USSD (Unstructured Supplementary Service Data).
- Those who use other cashless payment modes, such as e-wallets, debit and credit cards, will not be eligible for the Lucky Grahak Yojana and Digi Dhan Vyapar Yojana rewards.
- Also, to be eligible for the Lucky Grahak and Digi Dhan Vyapar Yojana rewards, one must make transactions between Rs. 50 and Rs. 3,000.
- Those who make purchases above Rs. 3,000 will not be eligible for the rewards in this scheme.

 2. Three Mega Prizes for merchants worth Rs 50 lakhs, 25 lakh, 12 lakh for digital transactions between 8th November, 2016 to 13th April, 2017 to be announced on 14th April, 2017

- The RBI kept keep the policy repo rate under the liquidity adjustment facility (LAF) unchanged at 6.25 per cent.
- The reverse repo rate under the LAF remains unchanged at 5.75 per cent, and the marginal standing facility (MSF) rate and the Bank Rate at 6.75 per cent.
- It may be recalled that Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on 5 October 2016 in its fourth Bi-monthly Monetary policy Statement cut repo rate by 25 bps to 6.25 per cent.
- Statutory Liquidity Ratio (SLR) remains unchanged at 20.75 per cent.
- Reserve Ratios Cash Reserve Ratio (CRR) of scheduled banks also remains unchanged at 4.0 per cent of net demand and time liability (NDTL).
- The MPC also has cut Gross Value Added (GVA) growth estimates for the economy in the fiscal year ending March 2017 to 7.1% from 7.6% earlier.
- The decision of the MPC is consistent with an accommodative stance of monetary policy in consonance with the objective of achieving consumer price index (CPI) inflation at 5% by Q4 of 2016-17 and the medium-term target of 4% within a band of +/- 2%, while supporting growth.

'Pregnancy fluid' could treat Osteoporosis

Question: Researchers of which country proposed that stem cells harvested from pregnant women's amniotic fluid can be used to strengthen weak bones?

Related facts:

- Researchers of Britain proposed that stem cells harvested from pregnant woman's amniotic fluid can be used to treat osteoporosis and strengthen weak bones.
- Amniotic fluid is the protective fluid that surrounds baby in the uterus and helps it to develop inside the mother's womb.
- Scientists proposed the unusual therapy after studies showed that the treatment led to 78% fewer fractures in animals that were bred to have a brittle bone disorder.
- The finding has raised hopes for treating rare bone conditions that affect some babies from birth, but the same procedure has the potential to help older people with osteoporosis, and even astronauts who lose bone mass in orbit.
- Pascale Guillot led the study at University College London.
- The Amniotic fluid also contains stem cells that are the building blocks of other tissues.
- The researchers collected the amniotic stem cells from material left over from screening tests during pregnancy or collected immediately before birth.
- The team at the Institute of Child Health – a collaboration of Great Ormond Street Hospital and University College London – injected the cells into diseased mice.
- Tests on mice showed injecting the cells increased the strength, plasticity and structure of the animal's bones.
- Bone is constantly being remade with cells called osteoclasts breaking down old bone and osteoblasts making new bones.
- Brittle bone disease, osteoporosis and space travel were all characterized by osteoblasts "becoming lazy".
- The study showed the stem cells were increasing the natural activity of the osteoblasts – rather than directly making new bone themselves.
- Clinical trials are already planned, but ultimately the researchers' aim is to discover which chemicals the stem cells are releasing that kick the osteoblasts into gear.

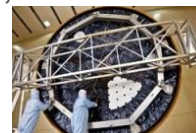

- It can withstand temperatures of nearly 4,000 degrees Celsius.
- Tantalum carbide (TaC) and hafnium carbide (HfC) are refractory ceramics, meaning they are extraordinarily resistant to heat.



- There has not been the technology available to test the melting point of TaC and HfC in the lab to determine how truly extreme an environment they could function in.
- The researchers developed a new extreme heating technique using lasers to test the heat tolerance of TaC and HfC.
- The compound TaC melted at 3,768 degrees Celsius, and HfC melted at 3,958 degrees Celsius.
- The recent finding may pave the way for the next generation of hypersonic vehicles, meaning spacecraft could become faster than ever.

- On 19 April 2012 with the successful test of Agni-V, India joined the super exclusive club of countries with ICBMs (Intercontinental Ballistic Missiles Club) (missiles with a range of over 5,000-5,500km) alongside the US, Russia, China and France.

TIFR Researchers Challenged theory of Superconductivity

Question: Discovery by scientist of which institute has challenges theory of superconductivity?

Related facts:

- An exciting discovery by Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR), Mumbai, recently published in Science (online 1st Dec 2016) has challenged the conventional understanding of superconductivity.
- A team, lead by Dr. S. Ramakrishnan of the Department of Condensed Matter Physics and Material Sciences at TIFR, has discovered bismuth semi-metal in bulk form becoming a superconductor when the temperature is lowered to 530 microKelvin (about -273 degree C).
- This is three orders of magnitude higher than the theoretical prediction.
- The Bardeen-Cooper-Schrieffer (BCS) theory [which explains superconductivity in most low T_c superconductors] cannot explain the superconductivity seen in bismuth
- Superconductors are materials that conduct electricity with no resistance whatsoever. To become superconductors, the element should have mobile electrons, and these electrons should come together to form pairs, known as Cooper pairs.
- Unlike other elements in the periodic table, bismuth has unusual phenomenon. While metallic superconductors have one mobile electron per atom, bismuth has only one mobile electron per 100,000 atoms.
Also, bismuth's electronic energy (Fermi energy) is comparable to the lattice (phonon) energy. So the conventional BCS theory and its extensions which assume that Fermi energy is two to three orders of magnitude higher than phonon energy is not valid in bismuth.
- BCS theory or Bardeen–Cooper–Schrieffer theory (named after John Bardeen, Leon Cooper, and John Robert Schrieffer) is the first microscopic theory of superconductivity since its discovery in 1911. The theory describes superconductivity as a microscopic effect caused by a condensation of Cooper pairs into a boson-like state. The theory is also used in nuclear physics to describe the pairing interaction between nucleons in an atomic nucleus.
- Tata Institute of Fundamental Research is a National Centre of the Government of India, under the umbrella of the Department of Atomic Energy, as well as a deemed University awarding degrees for master's and doctoral programs. The Institute was founded in 1945 with support from the Sir Dorabji Tata Trust under the vision of Dr Homi Bhabha.

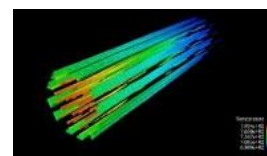

- The researchers have proposed an alternative mode of production, which forms the basis of powder metallurgy: electric pulse sintering under pressure.
- This new technology allows to obtain products of high quality and to reduce the number of production stages without increasing the cost.
- The main type of fuel for nuclear power reactors is the uranium oxide pellet composition which is produced from a powder by granulation, pressing, and sintering with the subsequent control of the quality and size of the pellets.
- The key idea of the new method is heating by an electric current passing through the mold with the powder placed in. Under these circumstances, the uranium oxide fuel is simultaneously influenced by the powerful pulse discharge and mechanical pressure.
- Using the new method, the fuel pellets may be produced even from uranium dioxide powder, which is not suitable for the conventional technology.
- With its help it is possible to obtain high-quality samples of fuel, including that for fast breeder reactors.

A Novel Approach to discover Drug Target

- Researchers from the International Centre for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology (ICGEB), Delhi have found a novel route to discover new drug targets and potential drugs for parasites that cause several diseases such as Loa loa nematode (roundworm) and Schistosoma mansoni platyhelminths (flatworm).
- Both these parasites cause a major health burden particularly in African countries. There are limited treatment options and there is the usual threat of drug resistance.
- There is little interest in developing drugs for these diseases by pharmaceutical companies; they are hence called neglected tropical diseases.
- A team led by Dr. Amit Sharma from the Molecular Medicine Group at ICGEB looked at Aminoacyl-tRNA synthetases (aaRSs) of the two parasites instead of blindly screening molecules, which takes a long time and is expensive.
- In the next step, the team picked up one of the enzymes and validated it as a drugable target. For that purpose, the enzymes were recombinantly produced and their activities were studied.



- The researchers studied the crystal structure of the enzyme with cladosporin. This revealed how tightly the drug binds within the active site of the enzyme. The researchers could understand the active sites of the enzyme and how the drug inhibits their enzyme activity.
- Once the team solved the crystal structure of the enzyme they were able to make an atomic map of all the interacting atoms of both the drug and enzyme. The crystal structure helped to identify the drug pockets in the enzyme where the drug binds.
- Once the genome sequence of any parasite is known then it becomes possible to look at the same interacting atoms in the highly conserved tRNA synthetase enzyme family and assess whether the drug will be able to inhibit the enzyme activity.
- A Research Paper to this regard was published in Journal PLOS Neglected Tropical Diseases.

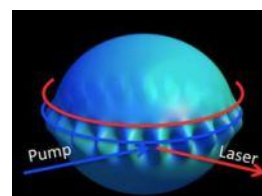

- In a report, published on 21st November, 2016 in the journal Nature Photonics Israeli researchers have demonstrated, for the first time that laser emissions can be created through the interaction of light and water waves.
- The study was conducted by Technion-Israel Institute of Technology students Shmuel Kaminski, Leopoldo Martin, and Shai Maayani, under the supervision of Professor Tal Carmon, head of the Optomechanics Center at the Mechanical Engineering Faculty at Technion.
- A typical laser can be created when the electrons in atoms become "excited" by energy absorbed from an outside source, causing them to emit radiation in the form of laser light.
- Technion researchers created a device in which an optical fiber delivers light into a tiny droplet of octane and water.
- Light waves and water waves pass through each other many times (approximately one million times) inside the droplet, generating the energy that leaves the droplet as the emission of the water-wave laser.
- Furthermore, a drop of water is a million times softer than the materials used in current laser technology. The minute pressure applied by light can therefore cause droplet deformation that is a million times greater than in a typical optomechanical device,
- The new technique may offer greater control of the laser's emissions and capabilities.
- This "water-wave laser" can be used in tiny sensors that combine light waves, sound and water waves, or as a feature on microfluidic "lab-on-a-chip" devices used to study cell biology and to test new drug therapies.

Successful launch of RESOURCESAT-2A into Polar Sun Synchronous Orbit

- On 7 December 2016; In its thirty eighth flight (PSLV-C36), ISRO's Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle successfully launched the 1235 kg RESOURCESAT-2A Satellite.
- It was launched from Satish Dhawan Space Centre SHAR, Sriharikota.
- This is the thirty seventh consecutively successful mission of PSLV.
- After PSLV-C36 lift-off at 10:25 am IST from the First Launch Pad with the ignition of the first stage, the subsequent important flight events, namely, strap-on ignitions and separations, first stage separation, second stage ignition, payload fairing separation, second stage separation, third stage ignition and separation, fourth stage ignition and cut-off, took place as planned.
- After a flight of 17 minutes 05 seconds, the vehicle achieved a polar Sun Synchronous Orbit of 824 km height inclined at an angle of 98.725 degree to the equator (very close to the intended orbit) and 47 seconds later, RESOURCESAT-2A was separated from the PSLV fourth stage.
- After separation, the two solar arrays of RESOURCESAT-2A deployed automatically and ISRO's Telemetry, Tracking and Command Network (ISTRAC) at Bangalore took over the control of the satellite.
- Like its predecessors RESOURCESAT-1 and 2, RESOURCESAT-2A has a unique 3-Tier imaging system with Advanced Wide Field Sensor (AWiFS), Linear Imaging Self Scanner-3 (LISS-3) and Linear Imaging Self Scanner-4 (LISS-4) cameras.
- The data sent by RESOURCESAT-2A will be useful for agricultural applications like crop area and crop production estimation, drought monitoring, soil mapping, cropping system analysis and farm advisories generation.
- The life span of the satellite mission will be 5 years.
- RESOURCESAT-2A is a Remote Sensing satellite intended for resource monitoring. RESOURCESAT-2A is a follow on mission to RESOURCESAT-1 and RESOURCESAT-2, launched in 2003 and 2011 respectively.
- The total number of satellites launched by India's workhorse launch vehicle PSLV including today's RESOURCESAT-2A has now reached 121, of which 42 are Indian and the remaining 79 are from abroad.

- In this match India's total of 759 for seven wickets declared is the highest score by any team vs. England, breaking the record of the 751 for five wickets declared by West Indies at St. John's in April 2004.
- In this test match Ravichandran Ashwin became only the fifth cricketer to complete 300 plus runs and more than 25 wickets in a Test series.

- At birth she was named Komalavalli and was renamed Jayalalithaa.
- She had entered into film industry when she was 16 years old and worked in 300 films.
- She had acted in Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam, Hindi and English films.
- She made her debut as the lead actress in Kannada films while still in school, age 15, in Chinnada Gombe (1964).
- She also appeared in a dance sequence of a song named “Malligeya Hoovinantha” in the movie Amarashilpi Jakannachari (1964).
- She acted in one Hindi film called Izzat, with Dharmendra as her male costar in 1968.
- Jayalalithaa was nominated and elected to that body in 1984 and retained her seat until 1989.
- After MGR’s death in 1987, Jayalalithaa proclaimed herself his political heir and, having fought off the faction headed by Janaki Ramachandran, MGR’s widow, emerged as the sole leader of the AIADMK.
- In 1991 Jayalalithaa became chief minister, Tamil Nadu’s youngest, for the first time.
- She served five terms(1st Term: 24.6.1991 – 12.5.1996; 2nd Term: 14.5.2001 – 21.9.2001 3rd Term: 2.3.2002 – 12.5.2006;4th term: 16.5.2011 – 27.9.2014;5th term: 23.5.2015 – Present) as the Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, for over fourteen years between 1991 and 2016.
- On 22 September 2016, Jayalalithaa was admitted to Apollo Hospitals in Chennai, as she suffered from infection and acute dehydration.
- On December 4, she was re-admitted to the critical care unit after suffering a cardiac arrest.
- On December 5, the hospital officially announced her death 23:30 IST.
- Two hours after the announcement of her death, in a simple ceremony at Raj Bhavan O. Panneerselvam was sworn in as the 20th Chief Minister of the state.

- On 28th December, 2016, The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, has approved a Centrally Sponsored Scheme namely "Road Connectivity Project for Left Wing Extremism (LWE) Affected Areas".
- The objective of this scheme is to improve the rural road connectivity in the worst LWE affected districts from security angle.
- The project will be implemented as a vertical under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) to provide connectivity with necessary culverts and cross-drainage structures in 44 worst affected LWE districts and adjoining districts.
- Under the project, construction/upgradation of 5,411.81 km road and 126 bridges/Cross Drainage (up to span of 100 meters) works will be taken up at an estimated cost of Rs.11,724.53 crore in these districts.
- The fund sharing pattern of LWE road project will be same as that of PMGSY i.e. in the ratio of 60:40 between the Centre and States for all States except for eight North Eastern and three Himalayan States (Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh & Uttarakhand) for which it is 90:10.
- Ministry of Finance will have to allocate to Ministry of Rural Development Rs.7,034.72 crore for this project during the period of implementation 2016-17 to 2019-20.
- The National Highways and the State Highways would be excluded from this project. The roads to be constructed under the scheme have been identified by the Ministry of Home Affairs in close consultation with the State Governments and the security agencies.

- Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) was launched on 25th December, 2000 as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme with the objective to provide all-weather road connectivity to all eligible unconnected habitations in rural areas of the country.
- The programme envisages connecting all unconnected habitations with a population of 500 persons and above (as per 2001 Census) in plain areas and 250 persons and above (as per 2001 Census) in Special Category States namely Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir and Uttarakhand, Tribal (Schedule-V) areas, the Desert Areas (as identified in Desert Development Programme) and in Select Tribal and Backward Districts (as identified by the Ministry of Home Affairs/Planning Commission).

- The Institute admitted 50 candidates each for BAMS (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine & Surgery) and BHMS (Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery) courses which commenced from 30th November, 2016.
- The Institute is affiliated to the North Eastern Hills University (NEHU), Shillong for both these courses.



- The seats are reserved for the states of North Eastern Region along with 24 (twenty four) seats under the All India Open Seats Quotas.
- The NEIAH is presently running with OPD and IPD (Ayurvedic & Homoeopathic) with qualified specialist doctors with all diagnostic and laboratory facilities.
- At present a 60 bedded Ayurveda Hospital and a 20 bedded Homoeopathy Hospital are functional.

Railway Ticketing to go Digital, Cashless Transaction at all Railway Stations

- On 2 December 2016 to encourage cashless transaction, Railways decided to install card swipe machines at parcel booking offices and all ticket reservation counters in all major stations.

- This will make railway travel bookings digital.
- Currently, the Railways does not provide POS service for debit and credit card payments at its ticket counters.
- Presently railway have around 12,000 ticket counters.
- All of them would be equipped with one or more POS machines depending on the daily transactions.
- The railways ministry will also go cashless for paying vendors and contractors.
- Railways already has 95% of its freight collection cashless. However, in the reserved category, it's just 55%.
- In unreserved category and monthly passes it's 100% dependent on cash payments as payment through cards was not allowed.
- In the first phase, counters at all urban centers would have the machines.
- In places like Mumbai, where there's a huge sale of monthly passes.
- Railways through its suburban railway network will provide incentive by way of discount up to 0.5 per cent to customers for monthly or seasonal tickets from January 2017, if payment is made through digital means.
