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

Related facts:



- The 40th session of the World Heritage Committee meeting was held in Istanbul on 10-20 July 2016.
- During the 10-day meeting on July 15, 2016, the Committee Included 4 sites worldwide in the UNESCO World Heritage List.
- In this three Indian sites are included in UNESCO'S World Heritage List
- This is the first time three sites of a country got included in the UNESCO World Heritage list in a single session of the meeting.
- This includes archaeological site of Nalanda Mahavihara (Nalanda University) in Bihar was included in UNESCO'S World Heritage.
- It is second in the list of UNESCO'S World Heritage from the state of Bihar, India.
- Earlier in 2002, Mahabodhi Temple, located in Bodh Gaya, became a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Alexander Cunningham had discovered the remains of Nalanda University.
- It was the world's first residential university, about 10 thousand students from around the world used to live for education.
- Among the incoming students the number of Buddhist followers was more.
- The university remained until the 13th century; the Ottoman invader Bakhtiyar Khilji burnt the university.
- The Capitol Complex in Chandigarh also made it to the list of UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- The third in the list from India is Khangchendzonga National Park (KNP) in Sikkim.
- Khangchendzonga National Park (KNP) in Sikkim is located on the world's third highest peak Khangchendzonga.
- There are 35(27 cultural and 7 natural sites and 1 mixed) World Heritage Sites in India that are recognised by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) as on July 2016.
- It may be recalled that The Great Himalayan National Park in Kullu, Himachal Pradesh and Rani-ki-Vav (The Queen's Stepwell) at Patan, Gujarat were included in the list of UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2014 during 38th Unesco's World Heritage Committee meeting in Doha.

New Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh

Related facts:



- On 17 July 2016 Pema Khandu was sworn in as the ninth Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh .
- He was administered the oath by Governor Tathagata Roy at the Rajbhavan in Itanagar.
- Chowna Mein was sworn in as the Deputy Chief Minister.
- On 13 July 2016 Supreme court in his historic verdict restores the political status quo in the Arunachal Pradesh as of 15 December 2015.
- On this date there was a Congress government led by Nabam Tuki.
- It may be recalled 20 rebel Congress MLAs (of the total 42), 11 BJP MLAs and two Independents. The rebels, along with the 13 others, passed the impeachment motion.
- The special session also moved a no-confidence motion against CM Tuki. At the end of the session, Tuki was 'defeated' in a floor test and the 'House' 'elected' Kalikho Pul as the new leader of the House.
- Due to political crisis, on 25 January 2016 on the recommendation of the Cabinet the President's rule was approved by the President.
- On 18 February 2016, the Supreme Court ruled to withdraw the order to continue the president's rule in the state.
- Following on 19 February 2016. The president of India, Pranab Mukerjee accepted the recommendation of the Cabinet to remove present's rule.
- On 20 February 2016 Kalikho Pul was sworn in as chief minister of Arunachal Pradesh.
- He was supported by 19 Congress MLAs, 11 BJP MLAs and two Independents.

- On 5 July 2016 Prime Minister Narendra Modi has expanded Union council of ministers.
- The newly constituted Union council of ministers of minister were expanded by 19 new Ministers of State.
- President Pranab Mukherjee at a function in Rashtrapati Bhavan administered the oath of office and secrecy to the new ministers.
- Prakash Javadekar, Minister of State with Independent Charge of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has been elevated as Cabinet Minister.
- List of newly appointed ministers includes the name of Ajay Tamta, Arjun Ram Meghwal, Fagan Singh Kulaste, S. S. Ahluwalia, Rajen Gohain, C.R. Chaudhary, Mansukh Lakshmanbhai Mandaviya, Vijay Goel, Ramdas Athawale, Anupriya Singh Patel, Nil Madhav Dave, Subhash Ramrao Bhamre, M J Akbar, Ramesh Chandappa Jigajinagi, Jaswantsinh Sumanbhai Bhabhor, Mahendra Nath Pandey, Parsottam Rupala and P.P. Chaudhary.
- Subsequently, the five ministers were removed from their posts.
- The five ministers are Sanwar Lal Jat Minister of State for Water Resources River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Mohanbhai Kalyanjibhai Kundariya Minister of State for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Nihal Chand Minister of State for Panchayati Raj, Mansukhbhai Dhanjibhai Vasava Minister of State for Tribal Affairs and Prof. (Dr.) Ram Shankar Katheria Minister of State for Human Resource Development.
- After this expansion, including the Prime Minister now there are total 78 ministers. Earlier the number was 66.
- This includes 27 cabinet ministers, 12 ministers of state (independent charge) and 38 Ministers of State.
- After this expansion, portfolios of some of the ministers has been changed as follows:
 - i. Smriti Zubin Irani-Ministry of Textiles
 - ii. Prakash Javadekar – HRD
 - iii. Ravi Shankar Prasad- Ministry of Law & Justice, Electronic and Information Technology.
 - iv. Narendra Singh Tomar-Ministry of Rural Development, Panchayati Raj, Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation
 - v. Chaudhary Birendra Singh,-Ministry of Steel
 - vi. Venkaiah Naidu- Additional charge of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting.
 - vii. Sadananda Gowda-Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation
 - viii. Manoj Sinha- Communications (Independent Charge)
 - ix. Anil Madhav Dave – Environment, Forests and Climate Affairs (Independent).

- On 20 July 2016 the Sustainable Development Solutions Network (SDSN) and the Bertelsmann Stiftung launched a new Sustainable Development Goal Index.
- The SDG Index and Dashboard collect available data for 149 countries to assess where each country stands in 2016 with regard to achieving the SDGs.
- The SDG Index ranks countries based on their performance across 17 goals.
- The index has been topped by Sweden with the score of 84.5.
- The next four countries in the list are 2. Denmark (Score -83.9), 3. Norway (Score -82.3), 4. Finland (score-81.0) and 5. Switzerland (Score -80.9).
- The Central African Republic is at the bottom of the list (149th rank) with the score of 26.1.
- Above this Liberia with the score of 30.5 ranked 148th.
- Congo (Score -31.3) is ranked 147 th, Niger (Score -31.4) 146 th and Chad (Score -31.8) at 145.
- India is ranked 110th in the index with the score of 48.4.
- Among the neighboring countries Bhutan 82nd place (score -58.2), Sri Lanka 97 th (score 54.8), Nepal 103rd place (score 51.5), Pakistan ranked 115 (score -45.7), Bangladesh ranked 118 (score -44.4) and Afghanistan ranked 139 (score -36.5) has been received.
- Among the BRICS countries Russia ranked 47th (score -66.4), Brazil 52th (score-64.4), China 76th (score -59.1).
- Among the developed countries, United States, ranked 25th (score -72.7), UK 10th (score -78.1), Japan 18th (score -75.0), Singapore 19th (score -74.6), Australia 20th (score -74.4), Germany 6th (score -8.5), and Canada 13th (score -76.8).

- Author James Patterson was ranked at the 3rd spot with the USD 95 million followed by Real Madrid footballer Cristiano Ronaldo 4th with the USD 88 million.
- This year only two Indian celebrities are included in the list.
- Shahrukh ranks 86th on the list with earnings of USD 33 million, while Akshay comes in on the 94th spot with USD 31.5 million earnings.
- Justin Webber is the youngest celebrity on the list and Paul McCartney is oldest celebrity on the list.

- On 1 July 2016 six militants opened fire on the Holey Artisan Bakery located in Dhaka, Capital city of Bangladesh in Gulshan -an affluent area with many embassies in Dhaka, Bangladesh.
- After the attack, all the people taken hostage by militants in the restaurant, among hostages almost all were foreigners.
- The operation to rescue hostages inside the Holey Artisan Bakery was launched by the Bangladesh Armed Forces named 'Thunderbolt'.
- The operation was led by the 1st Para-Commando Battalion of Bangladesh.
- The terrorist killed 20 hostages because they could not recite a verse from the Quran including Tarishi Jain, a 19-year-old female student of the University of California, Berkeley, of Indian nationality.
- In "Operation Thunderbolt" six terrorist were killed and a terrorist was caught alive.
- 13 hostages were rescued in the operation.
- Bangladesh's home ministry said in a statement that the attack was carried out by country grown terrorist group Jamaat-ul-Mujahideen.
- The home ministry also claimed that Pakistan's Intelligence agency ISI is also involved. But ISIS claimed responsibility for the incident.

- The Logistics Performance Index (LPI)-2016 provide comparisons across 160 countries by ranking them.
- Out of the 160 countries listed in the Logistics Performance Index (LPI)-2016, Germany topped the Index with the score of 4.23.
- The next four countries in the Index are Luxembourg (4.22), Sweden (4.20), Netherlands (4.19), and Singapore (4.14).
- Syrian Arab Republic is ranked at 160th position in the Index with the score of 1.60.
- India has improved its ranking in the World Bank Group's bi-annual "Logistics Performance Index 2016 by 19 ranks.
- India was ranked 54th in 2014 and jumped to 35th position in 2016 with the score of 3.42.
- According to the latest rankings India has left behind countries such as New Zealand, Thailand, Saudi Arabia, Iceland, Latvia and Indonesia.
- Among India's neighbour's Bangladesh ranked 87th (score – 2.66), Nepal 124th (score – 2.38) and Bhutan 135th (score- 2.32).
- Among the developing countries in the BRICS members China ranked (27th, score - 3.66), India (35th, score -3.42), Brazil (55th, score -3.09) Russia (99th, score -2.57) and South Africa (20th, score -3.78).
- Among the developed countries, United States is ranked 10th (score -3.99), Japan 12th (score -3.97), UK 8th (score -4.07), Canada 14th (score -3.93) and France 16th (score - 3.90).

- On 28 June 2016 Geneva based World Economic Forum has released its annual report named "Human Capital Report-2016".
- This year's World Economic Forum's Human Capital Report ranks 130 countries across the world.
- The index takes a life-course approach to human capital, evaluating the levels of education, skills and employment available to people in five distinct age groups, starting from under 15 years to over 65 years.
- The Index assesses Learning and Employment outcomes on a scale from 0 (worst) to 100 (best).
- Finland has been ranked as first with overall score of 85.86.
- The next four countries in the Index are 2. Norway (Score -84.64), 3. Switzerland (Score -84.61), 4. Japan (score -83.44), 5. Sweden (Score -83.29).
- Mauritania with the least score of 42.33 is ranked 130th in the Human Capital Index-2016.
- India with the score of 57.33 is ranked 105th in the Index.
- It may be recalled that in the human capital index -2015 India was ranked 100th with a score of 57.62 in the list of 124 countries.
- Among the neighbouring countries Bangladesh ranked 104th (Score -57.84), Nepal ranked 108th (score -57.35), Bhutan 91st place (score -61.83), Sri Lanka 50th place (score -71.69) and Pakistan 118th place (score 53.10) .
- Among the BRICS countries India is ranked below Russian Federation (28th, score -77.86), Brazil (83th, score -64.51), China (71st, score -67.81).
- Human Capital Index of developed countries is as follows :United States in 24th place (score 78.86), the UK's 19th place (score -80.04), Australia ranks 18th (score -80.08), France 17th (score- 80.32) and Germany placed 11th (score -81.55).

Related facts:



- On 21 July 2016 American business magazine Fortune has released the list of 2016 Fortune Global 500 list of the world's biggest firms.
- The overall list was topped by Walmart with revenue of 482,130 million US dollars, followed by State Grid at Second place and China National Petroleum at the third place.
- Others in the global top 10 companies include Sinopec Group (4th, \$294,344 million), Royal Dutch Shell (5th, \$272,156 million), Exxon Mobil (6th, \$246,204 million), Volkswagen (7th, \$236,600 million), Toyota Motor (8th, \$236,592 million), Apple (9th, \$233,715 million) and BP (10th, \$225,982 million).
- The world's 500 largest companies generated \$27.6 trillion in revenues and \$1.5 trillion in profits in 2015.
- Seven Indian companies have made it to the latest Fortune 500 list of the world's biggest corporations in terms of revenue.
- State-run Indian Oil Corp (IOC) ranked highest at 161st with revenues of US \$ 54 711 million.
- Second and third biggest Indian firms in revenue were Reliance Industries (RIL) with revenues of US \$ 43437 million and Tata Motors Ltd with revenues of US \$ 42 092 million with 215th and 226th ranks respectively.
- State Bank of India (SBI) with revenues of US \$ 41,681 million India's largest bank in terms of customer base came fourth after Tata Motors to occupy the 232nd rank.
- Bharat Petroleum Corp Ltd (BPCL) with the revenue of US \$ 29,082 million is ranked 358th and Hindustan Petroleum Corp with the revenue of US \$ 28 689 million ranked 367th were placed as the fifth and sixth, respectively.
- The surprise entry from India at the seventh position is Bengaluru-based Rajesh Exports at 423rd rank with revenue of US \$ 25 224 million, that has replaced ONGC in the list.

- On 13 May 2016 the World Bank Board approved a \$625 million loan to support the Government of India's program to generate electricity from widespread installation of rooftop solar photo-voltaic (PV).
- The Board also approved a co-financing loan of \$120 million on concessional terms and a \$5 million grant from Climate Investment Fund's (CIF) Clean Technology Fund.
- The project will finance the installation of at least 400 MW of Grid Connected Rooftop Solar Photovoltaic (GRPV) across India.
- The project will be implemented by the State Bank of India (SBI). SBI will on-lend funds to solar PV developers/aggregators and end-users.



Related facts:



- On 6 July 2016 World Economic Forum has released the Networked Readiness Index-2016 as part of its annual Global Information Technology Report (GITR).
- The Global Information Technology Report assesses the state of networked readiness of 139 economies using the Networked Readiness Index (NRI).
- The index assesses the factors, policies and institutions that enable a country to fully leverage information and communication technologies (ICTs) for increased competitiveness and well-being.
- The 2016 edition of the Networked Readiness Index ranked Singapore as the highest-placed country in the world when it comes to networked readiness.
- Finland, which topped the ranking in 2014, remains in second place for a second year in a row.
- The list is followed by Sweden (3rd), Norway (4th) and the United States (5th), which climbed two places.
- Other countries which are include in the top 10 are the Netherlands(6th), Switzerland(7th), the United Kingdom(8th), Luxembourg(9th) and Japan(10th).
- India has been ranked 91st in the Networked Readiness Index-2016.

- Despite of improvements in its political and regulatory environment (78th, up four) and in its business and innovation environment (110th, up five), India slips down two positions to an overall rank of 91.
- In year 2015 India was ranked 89th in the list.
- India's position on the list has come down for the fourth year in a row, from 89th in 2015, 83rd in 2014 and 68th in 2013.
- Among the India's neighbouring country Sri Lanka-63rd, Bhutan-87th, Pakistan -110th, Bangladesh-112nd and Nepal-118th.
- India (91st) is ranked the lowest among the BRICS nations- Russia (41st), China (59th), South Africa (65th) and Brazil (72nd).
- Malaysia leads the Emerging Asian economies in 2016 and moves up one spot to 31st position overall.
- The United Arab Emirates (26th) and Qatar (27th) continue to lead the Arab world in networked-readiness.
- The sub-Saharan African countries among the top upward movers, including South Africa (65th, up 10), Ethiopia (120th, up 10) and Cote d'Ivoire (106th, up 9).
- Europe remains at the technology frontier; seven of the top 10 NRI countries are European.
- The Global Information Technology Report series and the Networked Readiness Index (NRI) were launched by the Geneva based World Economic Forum in 2001.

- On 5 July 2016 the Union Cabinet has approved the Interest Subvention Scheme for farmers for the year 2016-17.
- Interest subvention has been provided to Public Sector Banks, Private Sector Banks, Cooperative Banks, Regional Rural Banks and NABARD for providing short term crop loan to farmers.
- The Government has earmarked a sum of Rs. 18,276 Crore for this purpose.
- This will help farmers getting short term crop loan payable within one year up to Rs. 3 lakhs at only 4% per annum.
- The main features of the scheme are:
- The Central Government will provide interest subvention of 5 per cent per annum to all farmers for short term crop loan upto one year for loan upto Rs. 3 lakhs borrowed by them during the year 2016-17.
- Farmers will thus have to effectively pay only 4% as interest.
- In case farmers do not repay the short term crop loan in time they would be eligible for interest subvention of 2% as against 5% available above.
- The Central Government will give approximately Rs 18,276 crores as interest subvention for 2016-17.
- In order to give relief to small and marginal farmers who would have to borrow at 9% for the post-harvest storage of their produce, the Central Government has approved an interest subvention of 2% i.e an effective interest rate of 7% for loans upto 6 months.
- To provide relief to the farmers affected by Natural Calamities, the interest subvention of 2% will be provided to Banks for the first year on the restructured amount.
- In case farmers do not repay the short term crop loan in time they would be eligible for interest subvention of 2% as against 5% available above.

- Highlights of FSR- June 2016 are:
- India’s financial system remains stable, even though the banking sector is facing significant challenges.
- As global uncertainties and transiting geopolitical risks impact India, continuation of sound domestic policies and structural reforms remain the key for macroeconomic stability.
- The global recovery remains fragile amidst weak and uneven growth, a slowdown in world trade and prevailing uncertainties in financial and commodities markets.
- The unintended side effects of current ultra-easy monetary policies being pursued in many advanced economies – without any clear signs of an exit strategy, are becoming evident.
- Indian economy at this juncture stands out in terms of growth and investment potential.
- With the Government’s commitment to continue on the path of fiscal discipline, the efforts on containing the revenue deficit and rationalising subsidies need to be reinforced, even as gross fixed capital formation needs a fillip.

- India's external sector indicators show a relatively stronger position. However, a faster growth in India's oil import in terms of volume in recent years makes it imperative to be alert to the risks of commodity cycle reversals.
- The prediction of a normal monsoon augurs well for agriculture sector growth in 2016-17, although the spatial and temporal distribution matter as much as the total quantum of rainfall.
- While stress in the corporate sector showed some signs of moderation in 2015-16, the risks of lower demand and weaker debt servicing capacity continue.
- The business of scheduled commercial banks (SCBs) slowed significantly during 2015-16.
- The gross non-performing advances (GNPAs) ratio increased sharply to 7.6 per cent from 5.1 per cent between September 2015 and March 2016, largely reflecting reclassification of restructured standard advances as non-performing due to asset quality review (AQR).
- The restructured standard advances ratio declined but with a marginal increase in the overall stressed advances ratio from 11.3 per cent in September 2015 to 11.5 per cent in March 2016.
- The capital to risk-weighted assets ratio (CRAR) of SCBs showed some improvement across the bank-groups.
- Asset quality of scheduled urban co-operative banks (SUCBs) as well as non-banking financial companies (NBFCs) improved.
- The performance of NBFC sector in general is relatively better than that of PSBs.
- Financial Stability Report reflects the overall assessment on the stability of India's financial system and its resilience to risks emanating from global and domestic factors.
- The Report also discusses issues relating to development and regulation of the financial sector.



- Columbia in a match for third place, defeating the US by 1-0.
- The major awards given in the tournament are as follows:
 - Golden Ball Award: Alexis Sanchez (3 goals) (Chile)
 - Golden Boot Award: Eduardo Vargas (6 goals) (Chile)
 - Golden Glove Award: Claudio Bravo(Chile)(Defended 13 Goals)
 - Fair Play Award: Argentina
- Chile became the fourth nation to win at least two consecutive Copa America titles, after Uruguay, Argentina and Brazil.
- Argentina, meanwhile, lost their third consecutive final in a major tournament, following a loss to Germany at the 2014 World Cup and Chile at the 2015 Copa America.

- On 24 July 2016 Railway Minister Suresh Prabhakar Prabhu has inaugurated First Green Train Corridor namely “Rameswaram-Manamadurai” free from human waste discharge.
- In order to contribute to mission ‘Swachh Bharat Abhiyan’ launched by Prime Minister of India, Ministry of Railways have taken up a mammoth task of providing human discharge free bio-toilets in all its coaches and the same would be completed by September 2019.
- With provision of bio-toilets in all its coaches’ discharge of human waste from trains on to the ground would be completely stopped which in turn would help in improving cleanliness and hygiene.
- Ministry of Railways has already provided 40,750 bio-toilets in its coaches till 30th June, 2016 and in the current financial year, it is planned to fit additional 30,000 bio-toilets.
- The Rameswam-Manamadurai (114 Kms) track was identified to make it Green Train Corridors- free from human waste discharge from trains.
- Accordingly, 10 passenger trains consisting of 286 coaches moving over this section have been provided with bio-toilets.

- After Rameswarm-Manamadurai, Okha-Kanalas Junction (141 Kms), Porbandar-Wansjaliya (34 Kms) and Jammu-Katra (78 Kms) would also be taken up for making them free from human waste discharge from trains.
- For this around 35 trains consisting of nearly 1110 coaches would be further provided with bio toilets and the work is underway.

- The technology has been developed jointly by Indian Railways (IR) and Defence Research & Development Organization (DRDO) for railway passenger coaches through an MoU.
- This environment friendly, low cost and robust technology is the first of its kind in Railway Systems in the world.
- In the bio-toilet fitted coaches, human waste is collected in tanks below the toilets and the same is decomposed by a consortium of bacteria.

- TRI-NETRA system shall be made up of high-resolution optical video camera, high sensitivity infra-red video camera and additionally a radar-based terrain mapping system.
- These three components of the system shall act as three eyes (Tri-Netra) of the Locomotive Pilot.
- During fog, heavy rain and also during night, the locomotive pilots face serious challenges in looking out ahead to spot any obstruction on the track such as vehicles which get stuck while crossing the track or trees or boulders which have fallen across the track etc.
- The concept of TRI-NETRA was developed by Development Cell under the guidance of Member Mechanical, Railway Board while brainstorming on how to use the technology employed by fighter aircrafts to see through clouds and operate in pitch darkness and the technology used by naval ships in mapping the ocean floor and navigating in the night.
- There has been very enthusiastic response to this Expression of Interest (EoI) published by Railway Board and number of companies from Israel, Finland, USA and Austria have expressed interest in developing such a system.







- Online one common Registration through a simplified procedure.
- Powers of Government to make rules regarding adequate measures to be taken by the employer for the safety and health of workers.
- Basic facilities like Clean and safe drinking water, Lavatory, creche, first aid and canteen by group of establishments, in case, it is not possible due to constraint in space or otherwise by individual establishment.
- Five paid festival holidays in addition to national holidays etc.
- Exemption of highly skilled workers (for example workers employed in IT, Biotechnology and R&D division) from daily working hours of 9 hours and weekly working hours of 48 hours subject to maximum 125 over-time hours in a quarter.
- The Model Bill would bring about uniformity in the legislative provisions, making it easier for all the States to adopt it.
- The bill will ensure uniform working conditions across the country and facilitate the ease of doing business and generate employment opportunities.

- The disease mostly affects children under the age of 15 years.



“Kendrapara sheep”- a new breed of sheep

- On 10 July 2016 National Bureau of Animal Genetic Resources (NBAGR) has formally accorded registered breed status on “Kendrapara sheep”, an indigenous variety mainly found in Odisha state.
- Locally it is called as ‘kuji mendha’.
- It is the 42nd sheep breed to have been registered in India.
- It is a typical breed of sheep. These sheep are fast breeders giving multiple births while those in other parts of the state give single birth at a time.
- Kendrapara breed was identified as the second in India and sixth in the world to carry the FecB mutation gene responsible for multiple births such as twins and triplets.
- Similarly, in the Sundarbans area of West Bengal, Garol breed sheep are found who are multiple-breeders.
- These sheep are mostly brown in colour. Head, face, belly and legs are bare. Rest of the body is covered with non-lustrous hair.
- Animals have horizontal ears; short, straight and drooping tail. Button type horns in few males.
- Adult body weight varies from 24 to 30kg. Estimated population is about 1,23,000.
- These are primarily used for production of mutton.
- It should be known that the Breed Registration Committee in its meeting on 21st June, 2016 at New Delhi approved registration of nine new breeds of livestock and poultry.
- This includes one breed of cattle, two breeds each of goat and sheep, three breeds of pig, and one breed of chicken.
- After including these newly registered breeds, the total number of indigenous breeds now in the country is 160, which includes 40 for cattle, 13 for buffalo, 26 for goat, 42 for sheep, 6 for horses & ponies, 9 for camel, 6 for pig, 1 for donkey and 17 for chicken.

- Its length is 82 Km.
- The canal connects the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans.
- Panama Canal consists of three lock systems.
- That is why this project is also called as the Third Set of Locks Project.
- The inaugural transit began with the passage of Neopanamax vessel COSCO Shipping Panama through the Agua Clara Locks on the Atlantic side of the country and concluded with its transit through the Cocoli Locks on the Pacific side.
- The ship of 366 m. Long and 49 m. Wide can pass through the canal.
- Panama with a population of 38 million, largely dependent on the Panama Canal for its revenue.
- After the construction of New dams (Locks) 96 per cent of the ship will be able to use it.
- The Panama Canal is a man-made 48-mile (77 km) progress through the fresh water lake "Gatun".
- The canal cuts across the Isthmus of Panama and is a key conduit for international maritime trade. There are locks at each end to lift ships up to Gatun Lake, an artificial lake created to reduce the amount of excavation work required for the canal, 26 metres (85 ft) above sea level.

- Dutee became the first Indian woman athlete in 36 years to qualify for 100 metres race in an Olympics after legendary P T Usha competed in the 1980 Moscow Games.
- Dutee became the first Indian woman to qualify for the event since qualification started for the event.
- Earlier P.T Usha had participated for the event in Olympics. But then there was no qualification system.
- P.T Usha secured fourth position in the finals of 1980 Moscow Olympics.
- Dutee is the first athlete from the state of Odisha who has qualified for the Olympics in an individual event.
