Rio Olympics 2016

Related facts:



- The 2016 Summer Olympics officially known as the Games of the XXXI Olympiad and commonly known as Rio 2016 was a major international multi-sport event held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, from 5 August to 21 August 2016.
- In November 2014 Vinicius and Tom are announced as the official mascots of the 2016 Summer Olympics and Paralympics respectively in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.
- More than 11,000 athletes from 207 National Olympic Committees, including first time entrants Kosovo, South Sudan, and the Refugee, took part.
- With 306 sets of medals, the games featured 28 Olympic sports.

India at the Rio Olympics 2016

- The Indian Olympic Association (IOA) had sent a total of 123 athletes.
- This was the nation's largest ever delegation in Summer Olympic history.
- Badminton player P V Sindhu won historic silver medal in women's singles badminton event.
- With this, she became the first Indian woman to clinch a silver medal in Olympics.
- Sindhu become the fifth female athlete from India to a medal in Olympics.
- Wrestler Sakshi Malik secured a bronze in the 58 kg category to become India's first female wrestler to win an Olympic medal.
- Dipa Karmakar became the first Indian female ever to book an Olympic spot in the apparatus events and all-around event at the Olympic Test Event.
- Indian athletes have won a total of 28 medals so far, all at the Olympic Games

Michael Phelps

- Michael Phelps has won the most individual medals including 5 Gold and 1 silver.
- Phelps was chosen as the American flag bearer at the opening ceremony, the first Olympic opening ceremony that he would attend.
- He is 18-time Olympic gold medalist, who currently holds seven world records in swimming.
- He is the most decorated Olympian of all time, with a total of 28 medals 23 gold, 3 silver and 2 bronze medals.
- Phelps also holds the all-time records for Olympic gold medals (18, double the second highest record holders), Olympic gold medals in individual events (11), and Olympic medals in individual events for a male (13).
- In his first event on August 7, the 4 × 100 m freestyle relay, he won his first gold medal of the 2016 Games and his 19th Olympic gold medal overall.
- In his second event on August 9, the 200-meter butterfly, he became the first swimmer in history to make five finals in the same event, after finishing 5th in 2000, 1st in 2004 and 2008, and 2nd in 2012.
- On August 9, Phelps won his 21st gold medal in the 4 × 200 m freestyle relay together with Conor Dwyer, Townley Haas, and Ryan Lochte.
- On August 11, Phelps won his 22nd gold medal in the 200 m individual medley.
- On August 13, in the 4 × 100-meter medley relay, Phelps ended his career with another gold medal, his 23rd at the Olympics and his 28th medal overall.
- Katie Ledecky won the second highest number of medals in the Oylmpics.
- She won a total of 5 medals including 4 gold and 1 siver medal.
- At the 2016 Rio Olympics, Bolt won the 100 metres gold medal with a time of 9.81 seconds. With this win, Bolt became the first athlete to win the event three times at the Olympic Games.
- He also won the gold medal in the 200 m, which also makes him the first athlete to win the 200 m three times at the Olympic Games.
- With the winning 4 x 100 m relay and he secured his third consecutive gold medal in the event.
- With that win, Bolt obtained the "triple-triple", three sprinting gold medals in three consecutive Olympics.

- The 2020 Summer Olympics will be held in Tokyo, Japan.

The Factories (Amendment) Bill, 2016

Question: Recently the Lok Sabha on passed the Factories (Amendment) Bill, 2016 that

Related facts:

- On 10 August 2016; the Lok Sabha passed the Factories (Amendment) Bill, 2016.
- The Bill amends the Factories Act, 1948. The Act regulates the safety, health and welfare of factory workers. The Bill amends provisions related to overtime hours of work.
- The Act permits the state government to prescribe rules on a range of matters, including double employment, details of adult workers to be included in the factory's register, conditions related to exemptions to certain workers, etc.
- The Bill gives such rule making powers to the central government as well.
- Under the Act, the state government may make rules to (i)define persons who hold management or confidential positions; and
 (ii)Exempt certain types of adult workers (e.g. those engaged for urgent repairs)
 from fixed working hours, periods of rest, etc.
- The Bill gives such rule making powers to both, the central and state governments.
- Under the Act, such rules will not apply for more than five years.
- The Bill modifies this provision to state that the five-year limitation will not apply to rules made after the enactment of this Bill.
- The Act permits the state government to make rules related to the regulation of overtime hours of work.
- However, the total number of hours of overtime must not exceed 50 hours for a quarter.
- The Bill raises this limit to 100 hours. Rules in this regard may be prescribed by the central government as well.
- The Bill introduces a provision which permits the central or state government to extend the 115-hour limit to 125 hours.
- It may do so because of (i) excessive work load in the factory and (ii) public interest.

Employee's Compensation (Amendment) Bill 2016

Question: In the recently passed Employee's compensation (Amendment) Bill, 2016 there is provision for removal of which of the following section from the original Act?

Related fact:

- On 9 August 2016 the Lok Sabha passed the Employee's Compensation (Amendment) Bill 2016 by voice vote.
- It was presented in the Lok Sabha by Labour and Employment Minister Bandaru Dattatreya on 5 August 2016.
- The Bill amends the Employee's Compensation Act, 1923. The Act provides payment of compensation to employees and their dependants in the case of injury by industrial accidents, including occupational diseases.
- Under the amendments Section 30 of the Employees' Compensation Act 1923 provides for appeal in high courts whenever the disputed amount of compensation is more than Rs 300.
- The bill seeks to raise this to Rs 10,000, which may be further increased through a notification later.
- The bill also provides for increase in penalty for contravention of the Act to Rs 50,000 from the current Rs 5000 that may be later raised to Rs 1 lakh.
- The Bill introduces a provision which requires an employer to inform the employee of his right to compensation under the Act.
- Such information must be given in writing (in English, Hindi or the relevant official language) at the time of employing him.
- In this there is provision for removal of section-30 from the original Act.
- The Law Commission of India, in its reports in 1974 and 1989 related to the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923, (now known as Employees' Compensation Act, 1923), had recommended to review/amend/repeal various provisions of the Act.

Related facts:

- On 10 August 2016 the Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi, has given its ex-post facto approval for amendments to the Maternity Benefit Act, 1961 by introducing the Maternity Benefit (Amendment) Bill, 2016 in Parliament.
- The maternity benefit Act 1961 protects the employment of women during the time of her maternity and entitles her of a 'maternity benefit' i.e. full paid absence from work to take care for her child.
- The act is applicable to all establishments employing 10 or more persons.
- The amendments will help 1.8 million (approx.) women workforce in organised sector.
- It Increases Maternity Benefit from 12 weeks to 26 weeks for two surviving children and 12 weeks for more than two children.
- 12 weeks Maternity Benefit to a 'Commissioning mother' and 'Adopting mother'.
- It facilitate' Work from home'.
- There should be mandatory provision of Creche in respect of establishment having 50 or more employees.
- The 44th, 45th and 46th Indian Labour Conference recommended enhancement of Maternity Benefits to 24 weeks.
- Ministry of Women & Child Development proposed to enhance Maternity Benefit to 8 months.

First unit of the Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project (KKNPP) dedicated to the nation

- On 10 August 2016 Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Russian President Vladimir Putin jointly dedicated the first unit of the Kudankulam Nuclear plant to the nation via video conferencing.
- The project is located in the Tirunelveli district of Tamil Nadu state.
- Tamil Nadu Chief Minister J Jayalalithaa also participated in video conferencing from Chennai.
- While the Prime Minister of India and Russian President Vladimir Putin participated from New Delhi and Moscow respectively.
- The plant is connected to the southern grid.
- The operation of the first 1,000 MW units at Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project started from midnight of the December 31, 2014 generating 1,000 MW.
- Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited. (NPCIL) is setting up two Russian reactors of 1000 MW capacity at Kudankulam.
- The Kudankulam 1 has been jointly built by the Nuclear Power Corporation of India and Russia's Rosatom and it had started generating electricity in 2013.
- The unit 1 and 2 of Kudankulam plant were built at a cost of Rs 20,962 crore. A major share of power generated in the plant goes to Tamil Nadu, followed by Karnataka, Kerala and Puducherry.

Annual report on "Registration of Births and Deaths in Delhi-2014

Question: Recently Deputy Chief Minister, Govt. of Delhi, Manish Sisodia released "Annual report on "Registration of Births and Deaths in Delhi-2014" prepared by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics. According to this what is the average number of births per day in

Related facts:

- On 3 August 2016 Deputy Chief Minister, Govt. of Delhi, Manish Sisodia released "Annual report on "Registration of Births and Deaths in Delhi- 2014" prepared by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics.
- The Sex Ratio (Number of females per thousand males) at birth increased from 895 in the year 2013 to 896 in the year 2014.
- Institutional births have increased from 3.02 lakhs (81.75%) in 2013 to 3.10 lakhs (82.83%) in the year 2014.
- The birth rate worked out to 20.50 per thousand Populations during 2015 as against 20.88 for the year 2014
- Moreover, about 66% of institutional births were occurred in the Government hospitals and 34% in private hospitals. Average number of birth per day in Delhi works out to 1024 in the year 2014 as compared to 1014 in 2013.
- The Infant Mortality Rate per thousand live births has reduced from 22.37 in 2013 to 21.66 in 2014.

- The Death Rate per thousand of population worked out to 6.82 during 2015 as against 6.77 in 2014.
- Maternal mortality rate per thousand live births was 0.37 in 2015 while it was 0.43 in 2014.
- Average number of births per day in Delhi worked out to 1025 in 2015 as against 1024 in 2014.
- Of the total births registered 197080 (52.69%) were male and 176932 (47.31%)
 female.
- The average number of deaths per day in Delhi worked out to 341 in the year 2015 as against 332 during 2014.
- 62.70% of the total deaths were reported by the medical institutions and the remaining 37.30% were domiciliary deaths during 2015.
- The analysis of major causes of institutional deaths during 2015 as per ICD 10 (i.e. International Classification of Diseases-10th Revision) reflect that 8.31% deaths were due to septicemia, 4.98% due to hypertensive, 4.66% due to tuberculosis, 4.28% due to shock (n.e.c.) and 3.84% due to disease of pulmonary circulation and other forms of heart diseases. The remaining MCCD deaths were due to other causes.

Related facts:

- On 6 August 2016 Minister of Urban Development
 M.Venkaiah Naidu launched 'Swachh Suvekshan-2017' to assess and rank 500 cities and towns based on levels of sanitation and efforts made by respective urban local bodies and also to capture progress towards achieving 'Open Defecation Free' status.
- He also launched a web portal 'Swachhata App' and 'Swachhta Helpline 1969' to enable citizens associate more and more with Swachh Bharat Mission in urban areas.
- Cities with a population of one lakh and above each, heritage and tourism cities, capital cities with less than one lakh population are included in this survey, the second since the launch of Swachh Bharat Mission.
- He launched 'Asli Tarakki' campaign highlighting the need for construction of toilets and using them well.
- This campaign to be mounted on TV channels and in print media soon brings out that having two wheelers, air coolers, TV sets etc., is not 'Asli Tarakki' (real development) if such people did not either have toilets or don't use them.

- Since the launch of Swachh Bharat Mission in October, 2014, construction of 21 lakh household individual toilets has been completed and construction of another 21 lakh toilets is in progress.
- The mission target in this regard is construction of 1.04 cr toilets by 2019.
- Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh and Kerala will become ODF by March, 2017
- Since the last survey, the Government of India has taken several policy and other initiatives to give a further momentum to the Swachh Bharat Mission. Briefly, these include:
- Waste to Energy power of 411 MW by 2018, as against the present generation of 53 MW:
- To promote conversion of Waste to Compost, Market Development Assistance of Rs.1500/- per ton of such compost has been announced.
- Swachh Bharat Mission Guidelines have been revised enhancing Viability Grant Funding(VGF)/Grant from Rs.26,000/- to Rs.39,200/- per each community toilet seat to be built:
- Over 150 Waste Management equipment have now been notified with DGS&D.
- Quality Council of India which conducted the last Survey in 73 cities will conduct the survey in 500 cities and towns.

- The index tracked changes in social or political unrest that could disrupt business operations across 197 countries.
- In this list Syria is ranked first followed by Yemen and Libya at second and third place respectively.
- India has been ranked 4 in Verisk Maplecroft's list of countries losing out on business opportunities due to civil unrest, after Syria, Yemen and Libya.
- The country features among emerging markets such as India (4th), Mexico (7th),
 Nigeria (10th), South Africa (13th), Argentina (15th) and Brazil (21st).

7th Meeting of SAARC Ministers of Interior/Home

Question: The 7th Meeting of SAARC Ministers of Interior/Home was held at-

Related facts:

- On 4 August 2016; the 7th Meeting of SAARC Ministers of Interior/Home concluded in Islamabad, Pakistan.
- This was preceded by the seventh meeting of the SAARC secretaries of Interior/Home on August 3.In which Union home secretary Rajiv Mehrishi has led the Indian delegation at the meeting.
- Apart from terrorism, other key issues discussed includes liberalisation of visa,
 illegal trafficking in narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances and small arms and how
 to make coordinated and concerted efforts to combat such menace.
- Union Home Minister Rajnath Singh led the Indian delegation in 7th Meeting of SAARC Ministers of Interior/Home.
- In addition, on India's behalf he had placed the following suggestions
 - 1. The will and the mandate of the international community against proscribed and wanted terrorists and their organizations must be respected and implemented.
 - 2. Attempts to distinguish between good and bad terrorists should be done away with, as this would be a mistake.
 - 3. Immediate and effective action is required against all those who support or encourage international terrorism in any way, whether they are state or non-state actors.
 - 4. Effective measures to be taken to ensure that those involved in terrorist acts do

not escape prosecution and punishment, and are extradited so that they cannot escape prosecution.

- 5. All member states, which have not ratified SAARC convention on Mutual Assistance on Criminal Matters, need to ratify the same.
- 6. Member states who have not yet given their acceptance to set up SAARC Terrorist Offences Monitoring Desk (STOMD) should give their concurrence for the same.
- 7. He made a special mention at the Conference on the number of new initiatives taken in India such as "Track Child" and "Operation Smile". In addition, I brought to the notice of the participants the measures taken by the Indian Government for honest, transparent and accountable governance through schemes such as "Jan Dhan Yojana" and "Aadhaar".
- The following initiatives were declared on India's behalf in the SAARC meeting of Home Ministers and Home Secretaries:-
 - 1. Technical assistance for effective implementation of STOMD and SDOMD
 - 2. To seek the concurrence of member states to participate in the second High Level Group of eminent experts to strengthen the SAARC Anti-Terrorism Mechanism being hosted by India on September 22-23, 2016. Fortunately all member states agreed.
 - 3. Capacity Building Programmes in India to strengthen drug control mechanisms of member States.
 - 4. Offered to host the first meeting of SAARC Computer Emergency Response Teams (CERTs).

- Matt Damon came in third with USD 55 million dollars.
- Tom Cruise is placed at the number four spot with earnings of USD 53 million and Johnny Depp at the fifth with USD 48 million.
- Bollywood stars Shahrukh Khan, Amitabh Bachchan, Salman Khan and Akshay Kumar are also among the world's highest paid actors of 2016.

- The project will enable Indian industries to design, manufacture and commission higher efficiency coal fired power plants with indigenously developed technology and manufacturing processes.
- This will be the first time large power plant equipment will be manufactured with advanced technologies, but without any Technological Collaboration/ Licensing Agreement with foreign companies.
- The proposed technology is still in research stage in all countries working on it. It is still not matured and demonstrated anywhere in the world.
- Power generation from coal contributes to about 38% of CO2 pollution in the atmosphere.
- 20% reduction in CO2 emission at source combined with 20% saving in coal consumption compared to a sub-critical plant and by about 11% compared to a supercritical plant are the primary reasons justifying this project.
- Use of this technology in all future large power plants will ensure energy security for the country for a longer period, along with a greener en vironment.

- The districts are Gurgaon, Faridabad, Jhajjar, Rohtak, Bhiwani, Sonepat, Panipat, Karnal, Mewa, Palwal, Rewari, Jind and Mahendragarh.
- The licenses to operate under the new scheme would be granted under section 74 and 76 of the Motor Vehicle Act. 1988.
- Under the scheme, the firms and societies, registered under Haryana Societies Registration Act, 2012 would be eligible for licenses. Further, companies that are formed to provide public transport services, and are registered under the Companies Act, 2013 would also be eligible for license.
- The scheme states that the licensee would be a taxi service operator and would have to abide by all relevant statutes as may be applicable including rules made under the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and rules made under the IT Act, 2000.



- He would have to ensure adequate space for parking the vehicles and would also have to ensure that GPS or GPRS device is fitted in the vehicle.
- Further, the licensee under group category such as firms, societies or companies would have to ensure that they have a registered office in Haryana. Details of the office such as telephone number, email id and details of office incharge would have to be provided to the Transport Department at the time of application.
- The licensee, who maintains a call centre or operate as an aggregator through an authorized call centre, web portal or app, will have to provide details of the same to the Transport Department.
- The scheme also contains provisions for rights of women employees under the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act. 2013.
- The scheme requires that the licensee display the women helpline number 1091 and police helpline number 1073, inside and outside of the taxi.
- The scheme also does not allow the use of tinted glass, curtains or films on the taxi.
- The cab would have a seating capacity of six people, excluding the driver. Open type or non-hard top vehicles would not be allowed to run.
- The taxis would be white in colour with blue colour strip on both sides displaying the name of the licensee.

 SLCCs comprise various regulators, namely, Reserve Bank of India (RBI),
 Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), National Housing Bank (NHB),
 Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority (IRDA), Registrar of Companies
 (ROC) and concerned State Government departments, such as, Home Department,

- SLCCs were reconstituted in 2014 in each State to monitor unauthorised collection

- As a result of the demerger, the income, expenses and profits of the parent company are transferred to the resultant companies.
- The Income Tax Act, 1961 takes into account these transfers from the parent company for taxation of resultant companies.
- Now the new bill clarifies that these provisions will apply in case a public sector company demerges, and the resultant company is no longer a public sector company.
- The Income-tax Act, 1961 state that in the case of certain assessees, in computing profits and gains derived from business, deduction shall be allowed of an amount equal to 30% of additional employee cost incurred in the course of such business in the previous year for the specified period.
- One of the conditions provides that the employee should be employed for a period of not less than 240 days during the previous year.
- In the present bill in view of the seasonal nature of the business of manufacturing of apparel, the period of employment of an employee who is employed in this business has been reduced from 240 days to 150 days during the previous year.
- It also seeks to increase the tariff rate of customs duty from current 10 per cent to the WTO-bound rate of 40 per cent on rough marbles and granite blocks/slabs.





 On 28 August 2016 the first experimental mission of ISRO's Scramjet Engine towards the realisation of an Air Breathing Propulsion System was successfully conducted from Satish Dhawan Space Centre SHAR, Sriharikota.



- The solid rocket booster carrying the Scramjet Engines, lifted off at 0600 hrs (6:00 am) IST.
- The important flight events, namely, burn out of booster rocket stage, ignition of second stage solid rocket, functioning of Scramjet engines for 5 seconds followed by burn out of the second stage took place exactly as planned.
- With this flight, critical technologies such as ignition of air breathing engines at supersonic speed, holding the flame at supersonic speed, air intake mechanism and fuel injection systems have been successfully demonstrated.
- The Scramjet engine designed by ISRO uses Hydrogen as fuel and the Oxygen from the atmospheric air as the oxidiser.
- ISRO's Advanced Technology Vehicle (ATV), which is an advanced sounding rocket, was the solid rocket booster used for today's test of Scramjet engines at supersonic conditions.
- ATV carrying Scramjet engines weighed 3277 kg at lift-off.
- India is the fourth country to demonstrate the flight testing of Scramjet Engine.
- Earlier, the US, Russia and the European Union had tested Scramjet Engine.
- The successful technology demonstration of air-breathing Scramjet engines in flight by ISRO is a modest yet important milestone in its endeavour to design and develop advanced air breathing engines including engines for ISRO's future space transportation system.

- Service sector accounted for 51 per cent share in gross state domestic product (GSDP) in 2014-15 thereby increasing from 49.5 per cent in 2004-05.



- At 46 years and 82 days, England crickter Jack Hobbs is still the oldest player to score a Test century.
- He scored 142 runs on 8 March 1929 in Melbourne against Australia at the age of 46 years, 82 days.
