Bihar Election Result

Question: How many seats in the Bihar assembly elections are reserved for Scheduled Tribes?



Related facts:

- According to the result announced by election commission on November 8, 2015, the grand alliance (RJD+JDU+INC) won 178 seats and the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) won 57 seats in the Bihar Assembly election.
- With this victory, Grand Alliance led by Nitish Kumar able to attain majority in Bihar election.
- Seat tally for Grand Alliance is: 80 seats for Rastriya Janta Dal (RJD), 71 seats for Janta Dal United (JDU) and 27 seats for Indian National Congress (INC).
- Seat tally of the BJP-led NDA is: 53 seats for BJP (Bhartiya Janta Party), 2 seats for Lok Jan Shakti Party (LJP), 2 seat for Rashtriya Lok Samta Party (RLSP) and 1 seat for Hindustani Awam Morcha (HAM).
- Communist Party of India (Marxist-Leninist) (Liberation) won 3 seats and 4 seats are won by Independent candidates.
- If we see the party wise vote share BJP got 24.4%, RJD 18.4% and JDU 16.8% of total votes.
- Independent candidates got 9.4%, INC 6.7% and LJP manage to get 4.8 % of the votes.
- RLSP got 2.6%, HAM 2.3%, BSP (Bahujan Samaj Party) 2.1%, [CPI(ML)(L)] 1.5% and Samajwadi Party (SP) 1% of total votes.
- For the first time Hyderabad-based All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen fought from 6 constituencies in Bihar and only received 0.2% of total votes.
- 2.5% of voters use the button NOTA (None Of The Above).
- It is to be noted that Bihar Assembly election notification was issued on 9 September 2015 because the term of the Legislative Assembly of Bihar is normally due to expire on 29-11-2015.
- The total numbers of Assembly constituencies in the states of Bihar are 243 and 38 seats reserved for the Scheduled castes and 2 for the scheduled tribes.
- Bihar election is completed in five phases in which 56.8% voters used their voting rights, total number of voters in Bihar is 66826658.
- The first phase of the elections held on October 12, 2015 in the 49 assembly constituencies.
- The second phase of the elections held on October 16, 2015 in the 32 assembly constituencies.
- The third phase of the elections held on October 28, 2015 in the 50 assembly constituencies.
- The fourth phase of the elections held on November 01, 2015 in the 55 assembly constituencies.
- The fifth and last phase of the elections held on October 05, 2015 in the 57 assembly constituencies.

Nitish Kumar sworn in as the 35th Bihar Chief Minister


Question: Nitish Kumar was administered oath of office and secrecy by Governor Ram Nath Kovind, Along with Nitish how many other leaders took the oath?

Related facts:

- On 20 November 2015 for the 5th time Senior JD(U) leader Nitish Kumar was administered oath of office and secrecy by Governor Ram Nath Kovind as 35th Bihar Chief Minister.
- Sworn in ceremony held at Patna's historic Gandhi Maidan which was witnessed by opposition leaders from across the country.



- It should be noted that on 8 November 2015 in the result declared by election commission the Grand Alliance won 178 of the 243 seats in the Bihar assembly.
- With this the grand alliance led by Nitish Kumar was able to obtain an absolute majority.
- Nitish Kumar for the first time in year 2000, took over as Bihar Chief Minister but he had resigned from his post after 7 days (the term from 3-3-2000 to 10-3-2000).
- In 2005, for the second time and in 2010 for the third time, he had assumed the post of chief minister of state.
- In 2014 he resigned from his position at the time when his party (JDU) disappointed with its performance in Lok Sabha election.
- As result Jitan Ram Majhi took over as the chief minister of Bihar from 20.05.2014 to 22.02.2015.
- But for the 4th time Nitish kumar resumed the office of chief minister on 22 February 2015 as Manjhi had revolted against Mr. Kumar.
- In 2015 sate election, Lalu Prasad Yadav led Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD) has won 80 seats, the highest in the state.
- Lalu Yadav's son Tejashwi Yadav is appointed as Deputy Chief Minister of Bihar.

Recommendations of Seventh Central Pay Commission


Question: Who is the chairman of 7th central pay commission?

Related facts:

 The 7th Central Pay Commission (CPC) headed by Justice AK Mathur submitted its report on 19 November 2015 to the Union Finance Minister Arun Jaitley.



- The commission recommended 23.55 percent hike in pay and allowances of government employees.
- The recommended pay revision will come into effect from 1 January 2016.
- The minimum pay for government employees is recommended to be set at 18000 rupees per month.
- The maximum pay is recommended to be 225000 rupees per month for Apex Scale and 250000 per month for Cabinet Secretary and others presently at the same pay level.
- The recommended rate of annual increment for employees is 3 percent.
- The commission has recommended increase in pay by 16 percent, increase in allowances by 63 percent and increase in pension by 24 percent.
- One Rank One Pension proposed for civilian government employees on line of OROP for armed forces.
- Ceiling of gratuity enhanced from 10 lakh rupees to 20 lakh rupees and ceiling on gratuity will be raised by 25 percent.
- The commission recommends Cabinet Secretary's salary from current Rs 90,000 to Rs 2.50 lakh.
- The total monetary impact on the central government would be Rs 1.02 lakh crore.
- Around Rs 74,000 crore would be the impact on the Union Budget and Rs 28,000 crore on the Railway Budget.
- The total impact of the Commission's recommendations are expected to entail an increase of 0.65 percentage points in the ratio of expenditure on (Pay + Allowances + Pension) to GDP compared to 0.77 percent in case of VI CPC.
- The commission has recommended that Military Service Pay (MSP), which is a compensation for the various aspects of military service, will be admissible to the defence forces personnel only.

• The current MSP per month and the revised rates recommended are as follows:

- Short Service Commissioned Officers will be allowed to exit the Armed Forces at any point in time between 7 and 10 years of service.
- The Commission has recommended abolishing 52 allowances altogether. Another 36 allowances have been abolished as separate identities, but subsumed either in an existing allowance or in newly proposed allowances.
- The Commission is of the view that in case of death in the line of duty, the force personnel of CAPFs should be accorded martyr status, at par with the defence forces personnel.
- The Commission recommends that HRA be paid at the rate of 24 percent, 16 percent and 8 percent of the new Basic Pay for Class X, Y and Z cities respectively.
- It has recommended a number of steps to improve the functioning of NPS. It has also recommended establishment of a strong grievance redressal mechanism.
- The Commission has recommended a consolidated pay package of Rs 4,50,000 and Rs 4,00,000 per month for Chairpersons and Members respectively of select Regulatory bodies.
- The Commission has recommended introduction of the Performance Related Pay (PRP) for all categories of Central Government employees.

Related facts:

- From November 12 to 14, 2015, the Prime Minister of India was on three day visit to United Kingdom (UK).
- This is first bilateral visit after 9 years.
- Earlier, Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh visited the United Kingdom in 2006.
- As far as bilateral relations are concerned with the United Kingdom, it is now 11 years of strategic relationship since 2004.
- United Kingdom and India are actually the leading investors in each other's countries.
- The figure of Indian investment in the United Kingdom is of 500 to 600 million US dollars annually for the past several years.
- UK has 122 Indian FDI investments.
- UK is an important partner of India in terms of trade.
- India's bilateral trade with UK is around US \$ 18 million.
- There is very strong partnership between the two countries in the fields like science and technology, education, health care and culture.
- There are 800 Indian companies operating in the UK and among them Tata is the largest employer in the private sector in U.K.
- Indian diaspora is the second largest diaspora in the UK.
- The number of Indian origin people in U.K is around 1.5 million.
- In U.K there are more than 3 Lakhs NRI living and they approximately constitute 2% of U.K population.
- During the visit, the Prime Minister addressed the United Kingdom's Parliament.
- He became first Indian prime minister to address U.K parliament.
- During his visit Mr. Modi inaugurated Dr. Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar Memorial in London.
- He unveiled Shri Basaveshwara Statue at the bank of Thames River in London.
- He met Queen Elizabeth II at Buckingham Palace.
- During the visit, the two countries signed a civil nuclear agreement.



- Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Prime Minister David Cameron took part in United Kingdom-India Summit in 2015.
- The two Prime Ministers endorsed a "Vision Statement" setting out the fundamental principles on which the UK-India partnership is built, and outlining a roadmap for deepening co-operation they resolved to hold biennial PM-level summits to advance the partnership.
- They also resolved to agree on a new Defence and International Security Partnership which will intensify cooperation on defence and security, including cyber-security, counter-terrorism and maritime security.
- Both the prime minister reiterated for addressing climate change and promoting secure, affordable and sustainable supplies of energy are shared strategic priorities for India and the UK.
- Prime Minister Cameron announced to fund 10 million pounds announced for the 5-year technical assistance program in order to bring power sector reforms r at national and state level in India.
- The two Prime Ministers welcomed a long-term strategic partnership between India and the UK on the former's flagship infrastructure investment initiative, the National Infrastructure Investment Fund (NIIF), and announced the setting up of a India-UK partnership fund under the umbrella of the NIIF.
- Prime Ministers Cameron and Modi noted the deep and fruitful business relationship between the UK and India and welcomed the £9.2 Billion of commercial deals between the UK and India announced during the visit and listed in the annex.
- The two Prime Ministers welcomed HSBC's "Skills for life" initiative in India, a £10 million programme to skill 75,000 disadvantaged young people and children over 5 years.
- The two Prime Ministers announced three UK-India city partnerships with Indore, Pune and Amravati to support India's ambitious urban development goals through technical assistance, expertise sharing and business engagement.
- The two Prime Ministers launched a new Thames/Ganga partnership for healthy river systems
- The Prime Ministers announced that UK will be the partner country for the 2016 Technology Summit in Delhi.
- The two Prime Ministers also welcomed establishment new joint science research centre.
- The two Prime Ministers announced that a UK-India Year of Culture will be organized in 2017 to celebrate our deep cultural ties and the 70th anniversary of Indian Independence.

- On the invitation of Indian Vice president Hamid Ansari ,Vice President of the People's Republic of China was on the visit to India from 3-7 November 2015.
- On 1 April, 1950, India became the first non-socialist block country to establish diplomatic relations with the People's Republic of China.
- During the visit, the Chinese vice president visited the caves of Ajanta in Aurangabad.
- On November 5, 2015 the Vice President met the West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee .
- On November 6,2015 he had bilateral meeting with Vice President Hamid Ansari at Hyderabad House in Delhi.
- After this vice president Yuanchao met Prime Minister of India.
- Then both the leaders of India and China highlighted the opportunities for cooperation between the railways, smart cities, and urban transport infrastructure.
- Both leaders agreed on the fact that peaceful, cooperative and stable relationship between India and China is important for regional and global peace and prosperity.

Trade and Commercial relations:

- In recent years, trade and economic relations between the two countries has grown rapidly.
- India-China bilateral trade which was as low as US\$ 2.92 billion in 2000 reached US\$ 41.85 billion in 2008.
- This made China India's largest trading partner in goods, replacing the United States of America.
- India-China bilateral trade for 2014 stood at US\$ 70.25 billion.

- On the invitation of Indonesia vice president Mr. Jusuf Kalla, Vice President Hamid Ansari was on official visit to Indonesia from 1-4 November 2015.
- India and Indonesia have shared two millennia of close cultural and commercial contacts.
- Since the adoption of India's 'Look East Policy' in 1991, there has been a rapid development of bilateral relations in political, security, defence, commercial and cultural fields.
- Indonesia has emerged to become the second largest trading partner of India in the ASEAN region.
- Bilateral trade has increased from US\$ 6.9 billion in 2007-08 to US\$ 20 billion in 2013-14.
- The bilateral trade in 2014-15 (April-Nov) amount to about US \$13 billion.
- India is the largest buyer of crude palm oil from Indonesia.
- In order to further deepen economic engagement between the two countries, the Indian Embassy in Jakarta launched the India Business Forum (IBF) on 18 July 2012.
- During his visit, Vice President Hamid Ansari met with the President of Indonesia Joko Widodo.
- Vice president of India had bilateral talk with the vice president of Indonnesia Mr. Jusuf Kalla.
- Two Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs) has been signed in the presence of both the leaders to strengthen ties in New and Renewable Energy sector and culture exchange area.

Compensation for Dropped calls

Question: TRAI (Telecom Regulatory Authority of India) mandates mobile operators to compensate the consumer

in the event of dropped calls, it will be with effect from-

Related Facts:


- TRAI has set the standard limit of maximum 2% for call drop.
- In practice this standard being violated by many companies due to which consumers has to face inconvenience.
- To protect the interests of consumers, Under TRAI Telecom Regulatory Authority of India Act, 1997 section 11 subsection 1 of clause (b) of clause (i) and (v) under Section 36 issued ninth amendment to the Telecom Consumer Protection Regulations, 2012.
- These Regulations shall apply from January 1, 2016.
- Under this regulation telecom operators will compensate consumers by one rupee for call drops into customer Balance (Account).
- The compensation will be limited to three dropped calls in a particular day(from 00:00:00-23:59:59)
- TRAI mandates telecom operator to send a message through SMS or USSD to the calling customer within four hours of the occurrence of call drop and the details of amount credited in his account.
- In case of post-paid consumers the detail of the credit will be provided in the next bill.
- TRAI will monitor the steps taken by telecom operators to minimize the call drop and if founds necessary it will review after 6 months.

Protest and argument by Service providers:

- Service providers are opposing this regulation, saying root cause for call drop is not economic and technical but it is due to political / administrative factors.
- They find following factors being responsible for call drop:
- Sealing the existing sites by corporation authorities
- Concerns of consumers regarding harmful effect of electromagnetic radiation led to difficulty in getting the towers to new places and Spectrum related issues.
- The companies believe that financial compensation would be futile and led to economic loss because the major portion of the call drop is out of their control.
- Call drop can occur due to problem in mobile of customer or it may takes place due to the flaws in either of sending and receiving network. However, the payment will be made by service provider which will be prejudicial to his business interests.
- Companies are concern about the fact that for economic benefits consumer may deliberately execute call drop.
- For solving the problem of call drop companies are stressing on requirement of the solid and sustainable support from central and state government.
- They are demanding declaration such as allowing telecom towers on government buildings, administrative transparency and technical cooperation.

Related facts:

- World Economic Forum (WEF) on 18 November 2015 released the Global Gender Gap Report 2015
- In this Gender gap index (GGI) WEF has included 145 countries whereas last year (in 2014) 142 countries were included in the Index.
- India is ranked 108th with a score of 0.664, out of 145 countries while last year it was ranked 114 in 142 countries.
- The Global Gender Gap Index examines gender gaps in four areas. These are as follows:
- 1. Economic Participation and Opportunity
- 2. Education Attainment
- 3. Health and Survival
- 4. Political Empowerment
- This index have 0-1 range, The 0 means complete gender inequality and 1 means full gender equality.
- India's performance in the report:
- Economic Participation and Opportunity-139th rank
- Health and Survival-143rd rank.
- Education Attainment-125th rank.
- Political Empowerment-9th rank
- Among BRICS countries South Africa is ranked highest (17th).
- Other BRICS countries are ranked as Russia 75th, Brazil 85th and China ranked 91st.
- Clearly, India ranked (108th) lowest among BRICS countries.
- There is no country which has scored 1 in this index, means any country in the world has not achieved full gender equality.
- Iceland topped the index (score -0.881).
- After that Norway ranked 2nd with the score of 0.850, Finland 3rd (0.850), Sweden 4th (0.823) and Ireland 5th (0.807).
- Five countries with least gender equality are Iran (141), Chad (142), Syria (143), Pakistan (144) and Yemen (145).
- The Global Gender Gap Index was first introduced by the World Economic Forum in 2006.


Related facts:

- 23rd Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) Economic Leaders (AELM) Summit was held at Manila, Philippines from 18 November to 19 November 2015.
- The summit was chaired by Philippines President Benigno S. Aquino III.
- The theme of the Summit was "Building Inclusive Economies, Building a Better World".
- Last year APEC summit was held at Beijing, China from 10-11 November 2014.
- Peru will chair APEC throughout 2016 and host the 24th APEC Economic Leaders' Meeting.
- The idea of APEC was firstly publicly broached by former Prime Minister of Australia Bob Hawke during a speech in Seoul, Korea on 31 January 1989.
- As the result of his efforts The Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) is a regional economic forum established in 1989, and 1st APEC Summit was held at Canberra, Australia.
- From 1989 to 1992 only representative level meetings of APEC countries were held.
- In 1993, former United States President Bill Clinton and Australian Prime Minister Paul Keating established the practice of an annual APEC Economic Leaders Meeting to provide greater strategic vision and direction to cooperation in the region.
- APEC has 21 members, Out of which 12 are founding members these are Australia, Brunei Darussalam, Canada, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, New Zealand, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and the United States.
- China, Hong Kong, China and Chinese Taipei joined in 1991. Mexico and Papua New Guinea followed in 1993.
 Chile acceded in 1994. And in 1998, Peru, Russia and Viet Nam joined, taking the full membership to 21.
- India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Macau, Mongolia, Laos, Colombia, Panama and Ecuador are the countries which are willing to join APEC.
- APEC has three official observers: the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Secretariat, the Pacific Economic Cooperation Council(PECC) and the Pacific Islands Forum(PIF) Secretariat.
- APEC's headquarter is in Singapore.

Related facts:

- On 13 November 2015 in the evening At least 129 people have been killed in a string of terror attacks in Paris.
- In this attack nearly 352 people were seriously injured.
- In a well planned terror attack maximum death occurred in Bataclan concert hall, a sports stadium.
- Around 89 civilians were killed in the hall and some people were taken hostage by terrorists.
- Gunmen opened fire on concert-goers watching US rock group Eagles of Death Metal This attack on the 1,500seat Bataclan hall was the deadliest as the hall was fully occupied.
- Most people in the hall in which three militant's attackers showered bullets died and several others were seriously injured.
- At the same time around 80000 football fans in the Stade de France (National Stadium of France) came under the deadliest attacks who were watching a friendly match between France and Germany.
- The first attack by militants was done at Le Carillon restaurant where they opened fire and the 15 people died and about 15 were injured.
- After this attack, militants attacked a bar in south of Paris where five people died and about 8 people were injured.
- In a similar attack two terrorists who attacked the Restaurant La Belle Equipe and killed 19 people.
- Total eight militants were involved in these attacks; including seven militants killed themselves in suicide bombing. One militant killed by security forces during raid.
- After the terrorist attacks emergency was declared in France.
- The Sunni militant group Islamic State claimed responsibility for the attack.
- It was formed in 2013 after separating from Al-Qaeda.
- The group is known in Arabic as ad-Dawlah al-Islāmiyah fī 'l-'Irāq wa-sh-Shām which means Islamic State of Iraq and Sham.
- This is world's richest terrorist organization who's head on June 29 in 2014, declared himself as the caliphate of all Muslims of the world.
- Emergency was declared for the first time in Paris after World War II due to this attack.
- After the attack in search of other militants Abdelhamid Abaaoud the Islamic State mastermind of the Paris attacks killed in a police raid.

- Institute for Economics and Peace (IEP) on 16 November 2015 released Global Terrorism Index 2015.
- It is third edition which provide a comprehensive summary of the impact of terrorism in 162 countries by representing it in terms of rank.
- In the list of Countries most affected by terrorism Iraq (score 10) ranked at the top for the third consecutive year.
- In this Index The index, Afghanistan (Score -9.233) is ranked Second, Nigeria (Score -9.213) Third, Pakistan (Score -9.065) fourth and Syria (8.108) is ranked fifth.
- Out of the 162 countries, India is the sixth most affected country by terrorism in 2014 with the score of 7.747.
- Last year also it was ranked sixth.
- In India 763 terrorist incidents took place during 2013 and 2014, reflecting an increase of 20 percent in the terrorist incidents.
- In year 2014, the number of deaths from terrorism reached to 416 which represents increase by one percentage compared to the last year.
- Terrorist activity increased by 80 per cent in 2014 to its highest recorded level. The largest ever year-on-year increase in deaths from terrorism was recorded in 2014, rising from 18,111 in 2013 to 32,685 in 2014.
- Fifty-seven per cent of all attacks and 78 per cent of all deaths occurred in only five countries; Iraq, Nigeria, Afghanistan, Pakistan and Syria.
- To measure the impact of terrorism Global Terrorism Index uses four types of indicators, the number of terrorist incidents, and the number of deaths, casualties and property damage levels.
- First Global Terrorism Index (GTI) was launched by the Institute for Economics & Peace (IEP) on 4 December 2012.

- The ministers of states like Spain, Azerbaijan, Malaysia, Senegal, Singapore, and Zimbabwe participated in the summit as Invited guests.
- Prime Minister Modi has represented India at the summit.
- Arvind Panagariya was the Sherpa for the 2015 G-20 Summit.
- The G-20 is an important platform for cooperation and consultation on matters related to international economic and financial system.
- G-20 includes 19 countries and European Union.
- The members of the G20 are Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Turkey, the United Kingdom, the United States and the European Union.
- According to the official website of G20 Antalya Summit The G20 member's countries comprises 85 per cent of global gross domestic product.
- G20 was established in 1999 after the East Asian financial crisis.
- After its the establishment every year since 2000, its member countries began a meeting of finance ministers and governors of central banks.
- In 2008, the first G20 Leaders' Summit was held, and the group played a key role in responding to the global financial crisis.
- Till the year 2010 it was held at the half-yearly basis, but since 2011 it held one in a year.
- It should be noted that on the first day instead of proposed economic agenda the agenda of international terrorism remains in the lime light, Prime Minister Modi advocated for very tough action against terrorism practices.
- On the final day of the conference, "Antalya" Action Plan was signed and Official press release was made.


- On 12 October 2015 the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI) released The Global Hunger Index-2015.
- Over the past year the index was prepared on the basis of three indicators Under Nourishment, Child Under Weight and Child Mortality Rate.
- In year 2015 GHI is based on four instead of three indicators that are Under Nourishment, Child Wasting, Child Stunning and child Mortality.
- This calculation results in GHI scores on a 100-point scale where 0 is the best score (no hunger) and 100 the worst.
- The theme of GHI-2015 report is Armed Conflict and the Challenge of Hunger: Is an End in Sight?
- According to GHI-2015 report, from 2000 to 2015 global hunger is fallen by 27%.
- In year 2000 GHI score was 29.2 and it improved to 21.7 in year 2015.
- Despite being improvement in the state of hunger the world's 79.5 crore people are still vulnerable to Starvation.
- The 2015 GHI has been calculated for 117 countries out of which 52 countries are facing serious or alarming levels of Hunger.
- In this year report, the lowest GHI score is given to Kuwait (score -5, first place) and two countries Saudi Arabia and Turkey, with 5.1 GHI scores have jointly bagged the second place.
- In global Hunger Index-2015 India is placed at 80th position while last year it was at 55th place.
- In GHI-2015 India found placed in serious category with score of 29.
- This year India got 15.2 points in under nourishment, 15.0 points in Child wasting, 38.8 points in Child stunning and 5.3 points in child mortality.
- Similar to the last year, This year also India has better condition as compared to Pakistan, (93rd place) While it has bad condition compared to Nepal (58th), Sri Lanka (69th) and Bangladesh (73rd).
- According to the GHI-2015 report more than one in four children are affected by malnutrition-related stunting and 9 percent of children are affected by wasting.
- In terms of geographies GHI-2015 is: South Asia and Africa south of the Sahara continue to experience the highest levels of hunger, with 2015 GHI scores, at 32.2 and 29.4 respectively, putting them both in the "serious" category.
- In contrast, the GHI scores for East and Southeast Asia is 13.2, North Africa is 11.5, Eastern Europe and some Independent states of commonwealth nations is 8.3 and Latin America and the Caribbean is 8.0.

- With an overall score of 3.504 points in the index Norway topped for the seventh consecutive year.
- Then Switzerland with the Score -3.337 ranked Second, Denmark with the Score -3.272 ranked Third, New Zealand with the Score -3.246 ranked fourth and Sweden with the Score -3.224 is ranked fifth.



- The 7th Central Pay Commission (CPC) headed by Justice AK Mathur submitted its report on 19 November 2015 to the Union Finance Minister Arun Jaitley.
- The commission recommended 23.55 percent hike in pay and allowances of government employees.
- The recommended pay revision will come into effect from 1 January 2016.
- The minimum pay for government employees is recommended to be set at 18000 rupees per month.
- The maximum pay is recommended to be 225000 rupees per month for Apex Scale and 250000 per month for Cabinet Secretary and others presently at the same pay level.
- The recommended rate of annual increment for employees is 3 percent.
- The commission has recommended increase in pay by 16 percent, increase in allowances by 63 percent and increase in pension by 24 percent.
- One Rank One Pension proposed for civilian government employees on line of OROP for armed forces.
- Ceiling of gratuity enhanced from 10 lakh rupees to 20 lakh rupees and ceiling on gratuity will be raised by 25 percent.
- The commission recommends Cabinet Secretary's salary from current Rs 90,000 to Rs 2.50 lakh.
- The total monetary impact on the central government would be Rs 1.02 lakh crore.
- Around Rs 74,000 crore would be the impact on the Union Budget and Rs 28,000 crore on the Railway Budget.

 The total impact of the Commission's recommendations are expected to entail an increase of 0.65 percentage points in the ratio of expenditure on (Pay + Allowances + Pension) to GDP compared to 0.77 percent in case of VI CPC.

- The commission has recommended that Military Service Pay (MSP), which is a compensation for the various aspects of military service, will be admissible to the defence forces personnel only.
- The current MSP per month and the revised rates recommended are as follows:
- Short Service Commissioned Officers will be allowed to exit the Armed Forces at any point in time between 7 and 10 years of service.
- The Commission has recommended abolishing 52 allowances altogether. Another 36 allowances have been abolished as separate identities, but subsumed either in an existing allowance or in newly proposed allowances.
- The Commission is of the view that in case of death in the line of duty, the force personnel of CAPFs should be accorded martyr status, at par with the defence forces personnel.
- The Commission recommends that HRA be paid at the rate of 24 percent, 16 percent and 8 percent of the new Basic Pay for Class X, Y and Z cities respectively.
- It has recommended a number of steps to improve the functioning of NPS. It has also recommended establishment of a strong grievance redressal mechanism.
- The Commission has recommended a consolidated pay package of Rs 4,50,000 and Rs 4,00,000 per month for Chairpersons and Members respectively of select Regulatory bodies.
- The Commission has recommended introduction of the Performance Related Pay (PRP) for all categories of Central Government employees.

• On 5 November 2015 RBI issued uniform guidelines on internet banking for Cooperative Banks.



- These guidelines are for all licensed cooperative banks including Urban Cooperative Banks (UCBs), State Cooperative Banks (StCBs) and Districts Co-operative Banks (DCBs).
- These guidelines relate to Internet Banking (View Only) facility and Internet Banking with Transaction facility.
- According to new guidelines all licensed StCBs, DCCBs and UCBs which have implemented Core Banking Solution (CBS) and migrated to Internet Protocol Version 6 (IPv6) may offer Internet Banking (View only) facility to their customers, without prior approval of RBI.
- In case, any service offered under 'view only' facility requires two-factor authentication or One Time Password (OTP), banks may adopt the security features related to internet banking as prescribed by RBI, as appropriate to such services.
- The cooperative banks providing above services should ensure that the facility is strictly for non-transactional services such as balance enquiry, balance viewing, account statement download, request for supply of cheque books, etc.
- All license holders Cooperative banks providing Internet banking with the transactions facility should be in a position to meet the following criteria:
- (Credit to Risk Adequacy Ratio) CRAR of not less than 10 per cent.
- Networth is Rs.50 crore or more as on March 31 of the immediate preceding financial year.
- Gross Non-Performing Assets (NPAs) less than 7 % and Net NPAs not more than 3%.
- The bank should have made a net profit in the immediate preceding financial year and overall, should have made net profit at least in three out of the preceding four financial years.

- In the General Budget, 2015-16, a provision was made for levying a Swachh Bharat Cess on all or any of the services, for the purposes of financing and promoting Swachh Bharat initiatives or for any other purpose relating thereto.
- Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (English: Clean India Mission) and abbreviated as SBA or SBM for Swachh Bharat Mission is a national cleanliness campaign by the Government of India, campaign was officially launched on 2 October 2014 on the occasion of Mahatma Gandhi's 145th birthday.



- Controlled Red, yellow and green light from the LED bulbs help in maintaining the environmental conditions required for the plant will be ready.
- The Zinnias will grow for 60 days, during the growth cycle; the LED lights will be on for 10 hours and off for 14 hours in order to stimulate the plants to flower.
- It is the first time that a flowering crop will be grown on the orbiting laboratory.
- Growing the zinnia plants will help in advancing knowledge of how plants flower in the Veggie growth system, and will enable fruiting plants like tomatoes to be grown and eaten in space using Veggie as the in-orbit garden.
- Growing tomato plants on the space station is planned for 2017.
- NASA's this plant growth system is known by the name of "VEGGIE" This system is related to the providing nutritional food for astronauts.
- The Veggie system was developed by Orbital Technologies Corporation (ORBITEC) in Madison, Wisconsin, and tested at Kennedy before flight.
- According to the scientist-Growing a flowering crop is more challenging than growing a vegetative crop such as lettuce because Lighting and other environmental parameters are more critical."

- Recently the P-8I aircraft had achieved a number of operational milestones which includes participation in the search effort for Malaysian Airlines Flight MH 370, the first successful firing of air launched Harpoon Block II missile in the world, torpedo firing and active participation in major naval exercises.

- Geosynchronous Transfer Orbit (GTO) will have a perigee (nearest point to Earth) of 250 km and an apogee (farthest point to Earth) of 35,819 km, inclined at an angle of 3.9 degree to the equator.
- ISRO's Master Control Facility (MCF) at Hassan in Karnataka took over the command and control of GSAT-15 immediately after its separation from the launch vehicle.



- In 2014 about 1.5 million deaths are caused due to Tuberculosis.
- This includes 8 lakh 90 thousands male, 4 lakh 80 thousands female and 1 lakh 40 thousands children.
- This is to be noted that Tuberculosis and HIV are two most important causes of deaths across the world.
- It is estimated that 9.6 million people were prone to TB worldwide in 2014.
- This includes 4.5 million males, 3.2 million females and 1 million children.
- In 2014 about 6 million new TB cases were reported to the World Health Organization.
- In 2014, 4 lakh 80 thousand people are found to have multidrug-resistant TB (MDR-TB)
- World Health Assembly in May 2014 adopted the goal to end the global TB epidemic by implementing the "End TB Strategy" to reduce the number of TB deaths by 90% by 2030 compared with 2015 levels.
- Of the 9.6 million new TB cases in 2014, 58% were in the South-East Asia and Western Pacific regions. The African Region had 28% of the world's cases in 2014.
- India, Indonesia and China had the largest number of cases: 23%, 10% and 10% of the global total, respectively.
- In 2014, an estimated 190 000 people died of MDR-TB.
- Globally, an estimated 3.3% of new TB cases and 20% of previously treated cases have MDR-TB
- Estimated 69% of countries recommended using Xpert MTB/RIF as the initial diagnostic test for people at risk of drug-resistant TB.
- In 2014 an estimated 1.2 million (12%) of the 9.6 million people who developed TB worldwide were HIVpositive.

- According to the report, by reducing short lived climate pollutants, reduction in illness and death can be brought.
- Also it will contribute to food security, improve diets and increase physical activity.
- The report spotlights the urgent need to reduce short-lived climate pollutants like black carbon, ozone, methane and carbon dioxide that contribute to climate change. This is to be noted that black carbon, methane, and ozone are often called as Short-lived climate pollutants (SLCPs).





- It has won two Nobel Peace Prizes, first in 1954 and second in 1981.
- Since 1986, the prestigious Indira Gandhi Prize for Peace, Disarmament and Development award accorded annually by Indira Gandhi Trust.
- The prize is accorded annually to individuals or organisations in recognition of creative efforts toward promoting international peace, development and a new international economic order, ensuring that scientific discoveries are used for the larger good of humanity, and enlarging the scope of freedom.
- The prize carries a cash award of Rs. 25 lakh and a citation.
- For 2014, Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) had received the award.



- These locomotives will cost about Rs. 19,000 crore.
- These locomotives are planned for use in the Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor and also for Pan India operations for hauling freight trains of 6000 tonnes at 100 kmph.
- It will also help in improving the average speed of such trains to around 50-60 kmph over the existing 25-30 kmph.
- Indian railways will hold 26 per cent equity in JV Company subject to a maximum of Rs 100 crore.
- The project would bring in an investment of Rs 1300 crore for setting of the factory and also the maintenance facilities.
- A joint venture company between railways and Alstom will now be incorporated and agreement between the two will be signed within the next 30 days .
- The project requires only five electric locomotives to be imported. The balance 795 locomotives are to be manufactured in India.
- The contract provides suitable economic drivers which would ensure complete indigenization of the manufacturing which in turn will lead to substantial development of ancillary manufacturing units.
- The project would also lead to development of the region where the factory would be set up and also those where the maintenance facilities would be set up.
- The project would bring in substantial development in these areas.
- It will also lead to generation of direct and indirect employment.
- This project will provide significant boost to the Make in India initiatives.






